

WARM FUZZIES

I am continually amazed at the number of churches which exist under names like "Church of the Rock". Why does someone joint and financially support the "Church of the Rock"?

As churches such as the iconic "Church of the Rock" seem to be popping up all around, it would be reasonable to say that these independent "boutique" churches are growing. They are growing while the Churches of Christ are declining. The January 2010 issue of the Christian Chronicle gives the headline "Membership decline is No. 1 story of 2009".

Whereas it is hard to generalize about what other people do, I want to suggest that attendees at the "Church of the Rock" get a warm fuzzy from attendance and sponsorship. It fulfills their natural desire and feeling of responsibility to worship God, and more or less lets them do it on their own terms. If the "Church of the Rock" teaches something they do not like, they can simply go to the "Church of the Tree" or whatever.

How does the Church of Christ compete with the "Church of the Rock"? First thing is that we can stop being judgmental that others are probably not going to Heaven because they are not following the Bible. Then we can be as warm and fuzzy as the Rock people. That seems to be what a number of our congregations are doing.

However, there is a problem with this beyond the fact that they are not following the Bible.

When they are warm and fuzzy, they are warm and fuzzy with no baggage.

When we are warm and fuzzy, we are still stuck with the Church of Christ reputation. Not only are we stuck with the Church of Christ reputation, but some of our members will not cooperate and go on insisting that people be baptized for the remission of sins and the such like.

If we abandon our Biblical basis and become warm and fuzzy competitors, we have the worst of both worlds. We lose our scriptural basis and nobody is going to like us anyhow. For the Churches of Christ, it is the sure path to declining membership. Seems like that is what we are doing.

What we see with some regularity is that when congregations want to become warm and fuzzy, they drop "Church of Christ" off their name, presumably for this very reason.

If the Church of Christ is to grow, it would seem that being warm and fuzzy is not the way to do it. It is appropriate to be friendly, but the church of Christ must remain true to the basic to "speak where the Bible speaks and remain silent where the Bible is silent" if we are to have a sound foundation for growth.

IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION!: RESORPTION OF ROOTS

Teeth are a very complex subject and a clear demonstration of the design of a higher intelligence.


Rather than discussing the obvious complexity of teeth in general, we want to discuss a specific thing which happens. It is called resorption of roots. When a baby tooth falls out, it is very short and it seems like it just lets go of a jaw bone or something. You know an adult tooth comes in quickly afterwards, but you probably don't (as I didn't) really think there is a specific connection.

In the graphic on the right, the left hand column the first 2 images describe the development of teeth before the child is born. The third graphic is at birth. The remaining graphics describe the development of teeth from birth to about 6 years old.

Notice first the front tooth in the fourth graphic (left column) and note that the baby tooth is in fact a tooth with a long root, and the starting adult tooth is already below it at six months old.

In the right hand column note the adult tooth grows below the baby tooth, and the root of the baby tooth progressively dissolves as the adult tooth grows. Finally one day the baby tooth is so short that it has no more support and falls out.

Can you imagine any way in which the bottom of the baby tooth knows how to dissolve as the adult tooth approaches, without being told to do so by an external intelligence? It would be impossible! This is truly one of the miraculous proofs of God which we take for granted.


