

SONS OF GOD MARRY THE DAUGHTERS OF MEN?

In the world in which we live skeptics, critics, unbelievers, atheists and agnostics are eager and willing to find fault with the Bible. Peter predicted accurately the future when he wrote: "Knowing this first: that scoffers will come in the last days walking according to their own lusts" (2 Peter 3:3). The book of Genesis is the battleground for the truth of the word of God against all the scoffers and critics who ridicule the sacred scriptures.

The fall of man, the serpent, the days of creation and the creation itself are all assailed by those well versed in the scriptures. It is also true that many so-called believers of the word have so misinterpreted some passages in the book of Genesis as to leave doubt to the truthfulness of the text. This fact is especially true of the account of the sons of God and the daughters of men who were said to have married each other in Genesis 6:4 ".... the sons of God came into the daughters of men and they bore children to them."

Many commentaries teach that these sons of God are angels and the daughters of men are human. As a matter of fact this seems to be the prevailing view among many religionists. Some more "liberal" writers say that Genesis 6 is a myth, much like a story from the Greek gods or the Roman deities.

The idea of the intermarriage of spiritual beings, such as angels with women, is based on the words, sons of God. This expression, "sons of God" is first used in the book of Job, perhaps the first and oldest book of the bible. (See: Job 1:6, Job 2:1 and Job 38:7)

Therefore, since the expression, sons of God obviously refers to spiritual beings (though it never says they are angels) many writers, believers and unbelievers take this expression to imply marriage between spiritual beings and fleshly beings (daughters of men). This view is false, ridiculous and disastrous to faith.

Why? The expression, sons of God, is not limited by scripture to one class, angels for example. As a matter of fact, Luke 3:38 describes Adam as a "son of God". Paul in Acts 17 quoted the Greek poet Aratus by saying "We are the offspring of God". In Deuteronomy 14:1 Israel is called "sons of God" and in 2 Samuel 7:14 kings (at least some of them are described as "sons of God.")

Paul described all those who are led by the Spirit as "sons of God" (See: Romans 8:14.). We can see therefore that this expression is not limited to angels.

Further, Jesus plainly taught that spiritual beings (angels) cannot marry nor are given in marriage. (See: Matthew 22:30). Clearly atheism is not based on scientific facts—it takes a lot of faith to be an atheist.


