

ARE YOU HUNGRY?

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled. (Matt. 5:6 NIV)

We understand the concept of physical hunger. We experience hunger every day and we look for food and drink to satisfy our bodies. Normally we eat several times a day or at least once a day anyway. Unless we are medically restricted or on a fast we will not delay eating until next week or next month. It all





goes back to hunger, our bodies routinely let us know when we are hungry.

But does your soul let you

know when it needs to be filled with Spiritual food? Are you listening for guidance? Often we are not even aware of what we don't know or what we don't have. God's righteousness is not something you will find accidentally. Intentional study of Scripture is needed daily because it is best absorbed in small servings. "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work." (2 Tim. 3:16, 17 NIV)

As an example we are being constantly bombarded with casual statements like the **light** from that galaxy has been coming towards us for a billion years and we seem oblivious to it.

Either we need to accept that it has been coming towards us for a billion years, or show why it hasn't. God sent the light no matter how long it has been coming.

The **14.7 billion years** light has been presumably coming towards us is based on the Cosmic Distance Ladder sequence of different kinds of measurements, based one upon the next. There are probably a hundred presumptions made upon this. The main presumption is the constancy of light in a vacuum. We are working to prove this is commonly held understanding wrong. We could use help in analyzing this if this is of interest to you.

The **Grand Canyon** is identified as being 70 million years old based upon present erosion rates. We have identified that the water to cut the canyon had to flow uphill 4400 feet to cut the canyon. Clearly that is not the case. (See Christian Array issue #55, thearray.org)

The reason for these examples is to show a tendency for scientists to interpret science to show as old a date for the start as they can. This fits nicely with the presumed long time it takes to have evolution create things.

Alternately, Christians are typically happy to accept the shortest date of 6-10,000 years in the literal translation of Genesis 1, with the interpretation that the days were 24 earth hours long. As the understanding of the length of the creations days is an interpretation of the book of scriptures, it might be well to look at God's science book to see what it says.

On the time light has been travelling towards us for presumably 14.7 billion years, we may get it reduced to considerably less than 14.7 billion years, but we are unlikely to get it to the

range of 6-10,000 years.

The Grand Canyon could have been formed in a relatively short period of uplift, so it is not a problem.

There is another observation we can make which is harder to deal with.

In the sedimentary layers, human artifacts have only been found in the Holocene or top layer. This layer would equate to the 6-10,000 years of the history of mankind. The problem is that the Holocene layer is never found to be more than 10% of the total depth of the sedimentary layers. (See graphic on page 3)

We have 2 basic choices here:

- 1. All the other layers are older than 6-10,000 years, so the days of creation were longer figurative periods.
- 2. All the layers were caused during the last 6 -10,000 years by a catastrophic event such as a worldwide flood.

The problem with the flood scenario is that:

- 1. It is a single event and should lay down a single layer, or a couple at the most,
- 2. Human artifacts should be in all the layers, in at least some locations, and
- 3. The other artifacts should be uniformly dis-


tributed in the layers if they were all formed at once somehow. As a practical matter, there are distinctly different species in different layers.

It is hard to imagine any way that you would interpret the geology of the earth to not indicate periods well longer than the existence of mankind, other than good intentions. Unfortunately, we are not in the good intentions business. We are in God's truth business.

God has written 3 books; the Old Testament, the New Testament, and the Universe. Each of them tell us information about God. They are all compatible and perfectly correct.

We need to listen to what all of them are telling us. We don't need to believe the interpretations some scientists are telling us. It does mean that at least some of us need to be equipped to respond to scientist's misinterpretations of science just like we need to be ready to respond to misinterpretations of God's Other two books.

IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION: CHAMBERED NAUTILUS

"The curious-looking chambered nautilus, also

known simply as the nautilus, is considered by many to be a living fossil."

"Like the <u>coela-canth</u>, it has remained unchanged for over

400 million years. During prehistoric times, there

were about 10,000 different species of nautilus, but only a small handful are known to survive today."

"Like most cephalopods, it can use jet propulsion to attain speeds of over two knots. A small tube near the animal's tentacles, known as a siphon, expels water under pressure. This propels the nautilus in the opposite direction at high speeds."

"The shell of the nautilus is comprised of many Individual chambers. Each chamber is individually sealed and contains an amount of gas. This provides the animal with buoyancy. The nautilus can regulate its density by injecting or removing fluid into these chambers through a system of tubes. This strong shell also provides protection for the animal's soft body. The nautilus has many more tentacles than its close cousins."

"These tentacles are used to catch shrimp, fish and small crustaceans, which the animal crushes with its powerful beak. Nautiluses are active predators, but since their siphon system uses very little energy while swimming, they only need to eat about once a month. Their eyesight is very poor because their eyes contains no lenses. Instead, there is only a tiny hole to allow light into the eye. This system operates much like a pinhole camera. The nautilus is thought to rely mainly on its sense of smell when searching for food or looking for a mate."


"Nautiluses are found throughout the Pacific and Indian oceans, where they spend their daylight

hours at depths of about 1,800 feet (550 meters). At night they migrate to shallower waters to feed among the coral reefs. The shell of the nautilus cannot withstand the pressure of depths greater than 2,600 feet (800 meters)."

Whereas there are several unique features of the Cambered Nautilus, the impossible we will discuss is highlighted in red. You might well think that a creature like this with a heavy shell would simply

sink to the bottom.



happening at a subsea pressure of 1800 ft. * .465 p.s.i. / ft. = 837 p.s.i. This is a higher pressure than most of us relate well to. Your car tires have about 30 p.s.i. in them. At somewhere between 100 and 200 p.s.i., they will explode.

At night it will pump some more of the water out of its shell to give it positive buoyancy and rise to shallow waters to feed. When arriving back at shallow waters they add water to achieve neutral buoyancy again.

All the Nautilus has to figure out how to do or to do by accident is to build multiple chambers which will withstand 837 p.s.i. ocean pressure, fill them with gas in a water environment, pump fluid into and out of the chambers at a 837 p.s.i. differential, and know how to control the amount of water in it to achieve neutral, positive, and negative buoyancy.

Generally, this is what a submarine has to do, and it takes sophisticated designs for submarines. The Chambered Nautilus is a sophisticated design also, and God is the designers. Yo litt whe
