

THE UNFORGIVABLE SIN

CONCLUSION: The unforgivable sin (blasphemy of the Holy Spirit) is to possess or witness the supernatural (miraculous) powers of the Holy Spirit and then to deny in word or act the power of the Holy Spirit. (This definition is offered here, it was not copied from another source.)

DISCUSSION:

It does not make sense that simply saying words about the Holy Spirit would be unforgivable, but the same words about Jehovah or Jesus would be forgivable. It must be more significant than simply saying words.

It does not make sense that the unforgivable sin is the unrepentant sin. That means that the unforgivable sin would be forgiven if repented of, making it not unforgivable.

It would make sense that for a person to have received the gift of the Holy Spirit in the form of miraculous powers that he performed, and then turn his back on God would elevate the situation to terminal.

Today the Holy Spirit typically performs activities only thru natural means, so it is probably impossible for a person to have the powers to commit an unpardonable sin at this time.

BE RECONCILED

“Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.” (Matt. 5:23, 24)

Broken relationships hinder our relationship with God. If we have a problem or grievance with another person we should resolve that problem as soon as possible. But to highlight

the issue, the writer says, “If your brother has something against you.” When we are aware that another person feels offended or has a grievance against us, by something we have done or said, we have

an obligation to seek reconciliation. .

God provides the perfect example. He was totally horrified with our sin. He could have turned his back, we deserve nothing, have nothing to buy his favor. He paid for our reconciliation. He didn't pay a little, or even pay his half, he paid it all. “Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation-” (Col. 1:21, 22)

Matt. 12:31-32 "Therefore I say to you, any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven men, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven. And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever shall speak against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age, or in the age to come."

Mark 3:29-30 "Truly I say to you, all sins shall be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they utter; but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin – because they were saying, 'He has an unclean spirit'."

Luke 12:10 "And everyone who will speak a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him: but he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him."

Understandings from other sources:

John Clayton in DOES GOD EXIST? teaches "Allowing oneself to be so controlled by Satan that nothing man or God does will be accepted is a condition, and "blaspheme against the Holy Spirit de-

scribes that condition. Our **refusal to accept God's grace** is what condemns us--not a careless oath."

COMMENTS FROM THE PEOPLE'S NEW TESTAMENT, by B.W. Johnson

Johnson comments on **Matt 12:31:** "**The blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven.** Compare Mark 8:28 and Luke 12:10. Much discussion has arisen concerning the nature of sin against the Holy Spirit, and nothing is plainer. Mark 8:30 explains it. It was ascribing Christ's works to demoniac influence. These works were wrought by the power of the Spirit."

Johnson comments on **Matthew 12:32** **“Whoever speaketh against the Son of man.** Personal injuries will be forgiven upon repentance. Christ prayed for his persecutors. Every sin can be forgiven but that against the Holy Spirit. **Speak against the Holy Spirit.** Perversely ascribe the work of the Holy Spirit to Satan. **Neither in this world nor that to come.** Judgment shall overtake him both here and hereafter. The Jews divided the two worlds, or, rather, *ages* of the world, by the coming of Christ. This would then mean that there is forgiveness to such a sin under neither dispensation. No passage in the Bible affirms more emphatically the doctrine of eter-

nal punishment. There is a sin that hath no forgiveness.”

Johnson comments on **Mark 3:30:** **“Because they said he had an unclean spirit.** This was a sin against the Holy spirit because Jesus did mighty works in the power of the Holy spirit, and they ascribed the power to an unclean spirit.”

Johnson comments on Luke 12:10: **“Blasphemeth against the Holy Spirit.** See notes on Matt. 12:31,32.

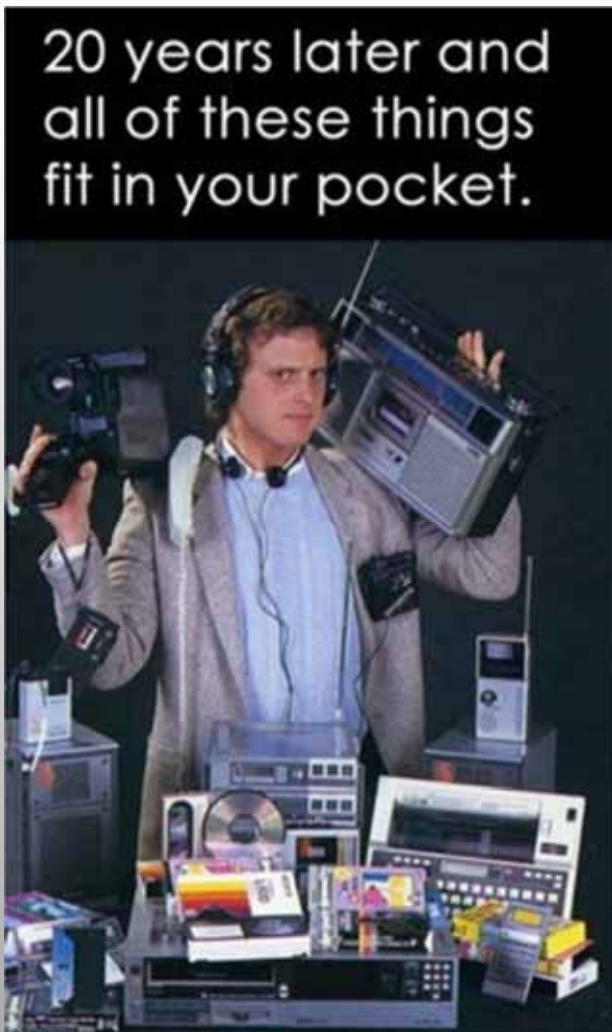

IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION—GOD PREVENTS EVOLUTION (APOPTOSIS)!!

Macro or creative evolution that is. We readily believe in micro or adaptive evolution.

The human body apparently has 37.2 trillion cells. Each cell has 3.2 billion base pairs of DNA, which is the coding language of living things. The DNA is divided into 20-25,000 genes, which are in 23 pairs of chromosomes, again in each cell. This will make sense in a moment.

We are going to suggest that you have difficulty getting your head around a number like 37.2 trillion. It looks like 37,200,000,000,000.

Every cell in the human body is replaced at least every 7 years, which means that there are 165,714 replaced every second. A number we can almost grasp. It takes about a day to divide, so there are 14.3 billion cells dividing at any time.

It is mind boggling enough that there are 14.3 billion cells dividing in your body at the moment and that they must reproduce with fidelity and be absolutely correct. That is not what this impossibility is about.

On watching a "Joy of Science" video sequence of 60 lectures, you see a wide variety of explanations of how evolution can happen. It is sold by The Great Courses and would be good for everyone to watch. There are some courtesy statements about maybe a God did something, but the general theme is that they simply haven't figure out how to exclude God yet. They do say some really interesting things though.

In Lecture #53, there is a discussion on cellular check points. It appears that when your 37.2 trillion cells divide with their 3.2 billion base pairs in the DNA coding, each cell has a quality control department.

After it duplicates 3.2 billion base pairs of DNA, it inspects it and if it is not correct it initiates a kill sequence and kills the cell.

After the correct DNA is put into your 23 pairs of Chromosomes, it stops and inspects the fidelity of the Chromosomes and if not correct it initiates the kill sequence and kills the cells.

The third check point checks to see if the chromosomes are properly attached to a spindle, and if not correct is initiates the kill sequence and kills the cell.

The name for this is **Apoptosis**. The Miriam-Webster dictionary defines it as "a genetically directed process of cell self-destruction that is marked by the fragmentation of nuclear DNA,

is activated either by the presence of a stimulus or removal of a suppressing agent or stimulus, is a normally physiological process eliminating DNA-damaged, superfluous, or unwanted cells, and when halted (as by genetic mutation) may result in un-

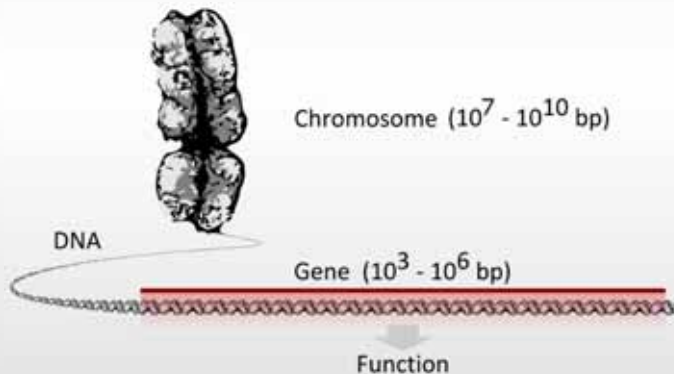
controlled cell growth and tumor formation — called also cell suicide, programmed cell death."

We would define it as impossible to be an accident of evolution. It would not be needed until the cells were defective. When they are defective you don't have a million years to evolve something. The defective cell multiplies and kills the host.

The theory of evolution is based upon numerous beneficial mistakes in the DNA. God prevents the mistakes with apoptosis.

Surely it took a highly intelligent designer to design this quality control department.

TERMS: DNA, CHROMOSOME, GENE

The following is simply a collection of definitions to help clarify the mind boggling amount of information we receive today.

DNA: is a molecule that carries the genetic instructions used in the growth, development, functioning and reproduction of all known living organisms and many viruses.

For instance, the DNA in the largest human chromosome, chromosome number 1, consists of approximately 220 million base pairs and would be 85 mm long if straightened.

In living organisms, DNA does not usually exist as a single molecule, but instead as a pair of molecules that are held tightly together. These two long strands entwine like vines, in the shape of a double helix.

DNA REPLICATION and topoisomerase. Next, one DNA polymerase produces the leading strand copy. Another DNA polymerase binds to the lagging strand. This enzyme makes discontinuous segments (called Okazaki fragments) before DNA ligase joins them together. (See graphic)

CHROMOSOME: A chromosome consists of a single, very long DNA helix on which thousands of genes are encoded. The region of the chromosome at which a particular gene is located is called its locus.

GENOME: The total complement of genes in an organism or cell is known as its genome, which may be stored on one or more chromosomes. A chromosome consists of a single, very long DNA double helix on which thousands of genes are encoded.

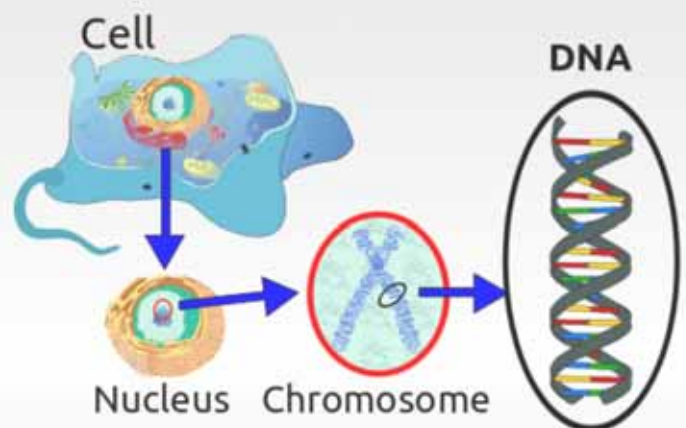
GENE: A gene is a locus (or region) of DNA which is made up of nucleotides and is the molecular unit of heredity. The structure of a gene consists of many elements of which the actual protein coding sequence is often only a small part. These include DNA regions that are not transcribed as well as untranslated regions of the RNA

RNA: ribonucleic acid, a nucleic acid present in all living cells. Its principal role is to act as a messenger carrying instructions from DNA for controlling the synthesis (production) of proteins and carbohydrates.

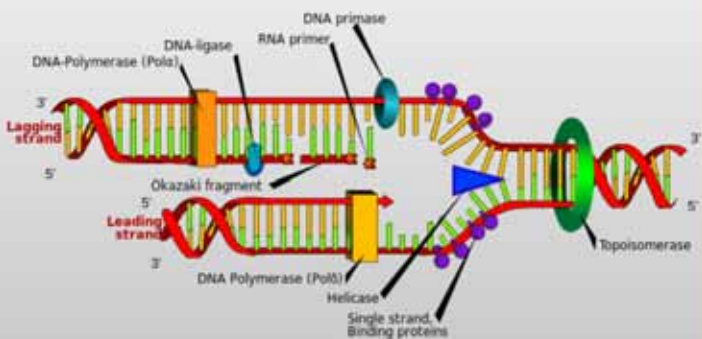
STEM CELLS: an undifferentiated cell of a multicellular organism that is capable of giving rise to infinitely more cells of the same type, and from which certain other kinds of cell arise by differentiation. When male sperm engages a female egg, the result is a stem cell. When this cell continually divides to make a person, it becomes more than 200 different kinds of cells (blood, bone, brain, etc.)

NUCLEOTIDE: a compound consisting of a nucleoside linked to a phosphate group. Nucleotides form the basic structural unit of nucleic acids such as DNA. It is the basic unit of DNA coding.

GENETIC CODE: The genetic code is the set of rules by which information encoded within genetic material (DNA or mRNA sequences) is translated into proteins by living cells.



The graphic above shows that your 37.2 billion cells have a nucleus containing 23 pairs of chromosomes, each having a portion of the 220 million DNA pairs, which are divided into thousands of genes.



This graphic shows the DNA to the right being divided at the Helicase, being matched with new DNA material at the center, and having duplicated DNA leaving at the left.

All you need to do to be an atheist is to believe this all happened by accident.

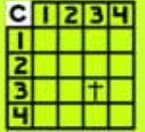

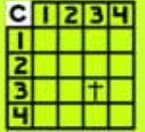
