To be more precise, the August 25 article in the Christian Post Reporter had the title "Disciples of Christ on track to lose half of its membership in 10 years." A good title, but too long to fit our format. The Disciples of Christ or Christian Church are of course a group which also claims a heritage to the Restoration movement, and

had a split with Churches of Christ in 1906. You would equate them with the liberal instrumental group and Churches as the more conservative acapella group.

That would related to a 6.7% average annual decline rate. Churches of Christ were declining about 0.5% 4 years ago and the decline has accelerated to 1.71% last year.

If our decline rate remains at 1.71% rather than accelerating more, we will only decline by 16% rather then 50%. Good news of a sort.

The Disciples of Christ were way ahead of us in going to instrumental music and other more liberal operating methods, but some of our congregations are trying to catch up with them.

The article was sent to us with the wording

What sort of person was Joshua?

Whereas we would agree with the implication that we are aging out, we have some heartburn with the statement of "traditional worship settings" as if that were a cause. There is a high degree of correlation between the two, but we would suggest they are not cause and effect.

As most of our readers will not have had an opportunity to see a non-traditional worship service, we are including some pictures of one we visited. On the first page was the **laser light show** which preceded the Sunday morning worship service. It was in a high school auditorium, and being older, we were invited to go to a separate class room setting which would not be so loud. Being there to get the whole experience, we went in the auditorium.

The pictures on this page are the singing service with a sizeable band and several singers, the entertainment during the communion service, and a sermon (which was good). It was an experience. Non-traditional worship services can come in a variety of styles. All are likely to start off more modestly than this, and it is not a guarantee that they will become this extreme.

Back more to the point, we would suggest that the cause of our decline is more along the lines of our traditional, optional operating style which both maintains a traditional worship style and discourages evangelism. That being said, our traditional worship style, especially acapella music, is one of our strongest points. We need to be focusing on making our acapella music better. Discouraging evangelism is a whole other subject. No one intentionally discourages evangelism, but we effectively do.

It ought to be reasonable to say that if we don't effectively evangelize our own kids we will lose them. If we don't effectively evangelize our neighbors we will not gain them. Those two factors equate to congregations aging out and dying, irrespective of worship styles.

Why would we suggest that our operating

style discourages evangelism. This topic is discussed in more detail in the topical paper OCCG-009 CHANGING ELDERS INTO

PLEASING GOD

Then the Lord said to Joshua: "As I was with Moses, so will I be with you; I will not fail you, nor forsake you. Be strong and of good courage; for you shall cause this people to inherit the land which I swore to their fathers to give them." (Joshua 1:5-6)

Near the end of his career, at a meeting at Shechem, Joshua challenged the Israelites al-


