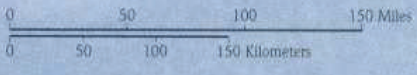

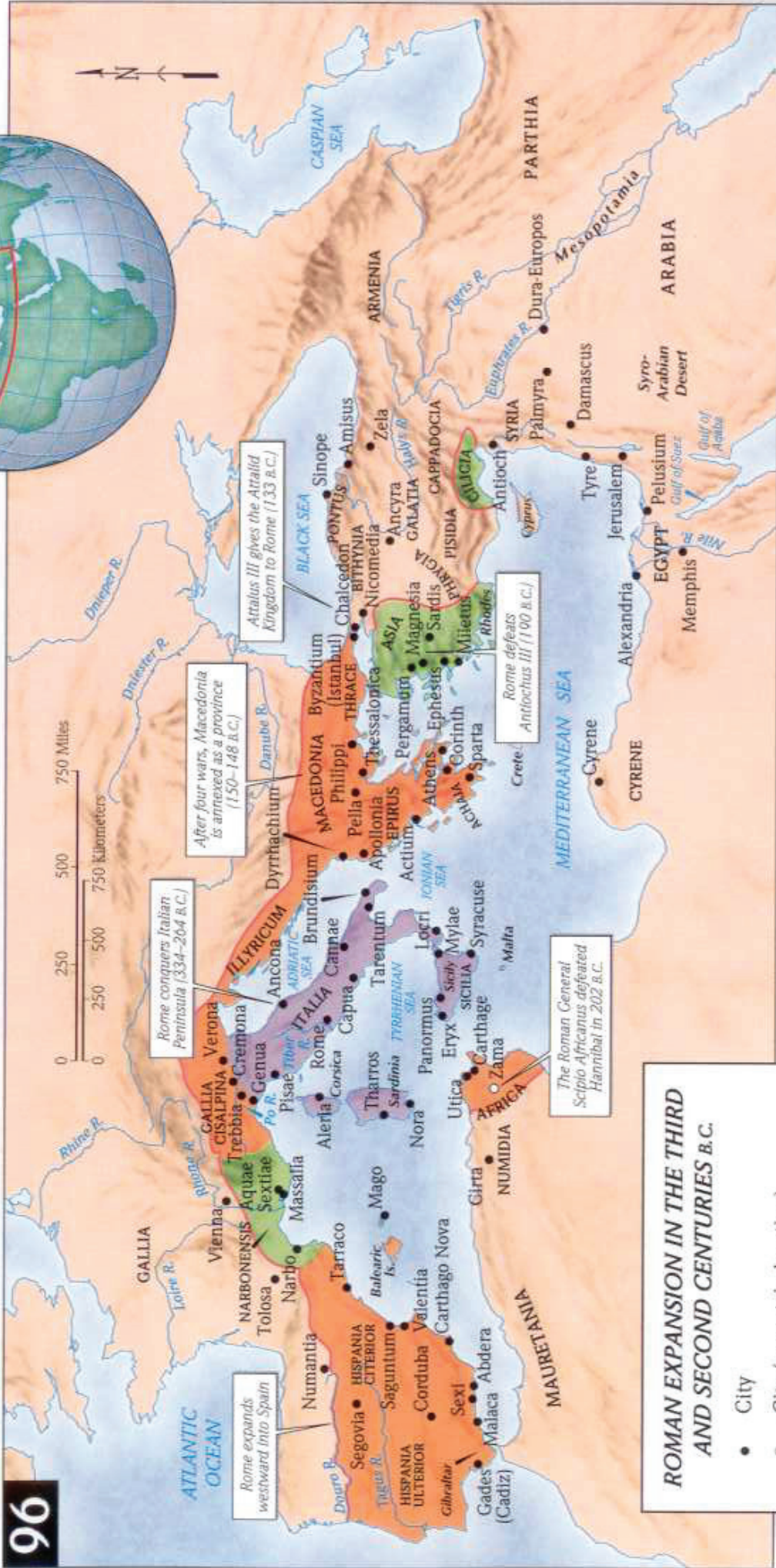

Early settlements of Latin tribes, 950 B.C.?



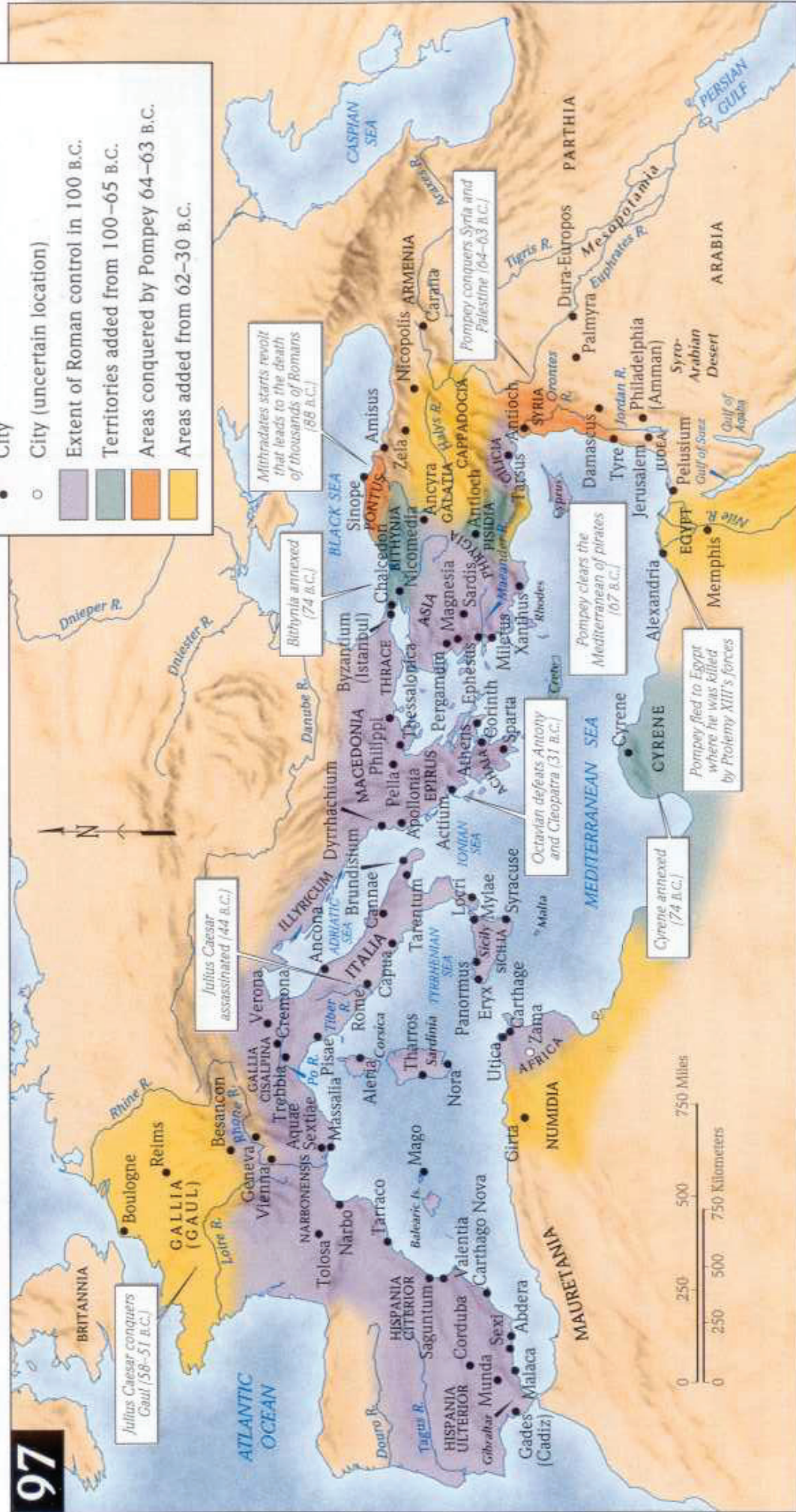


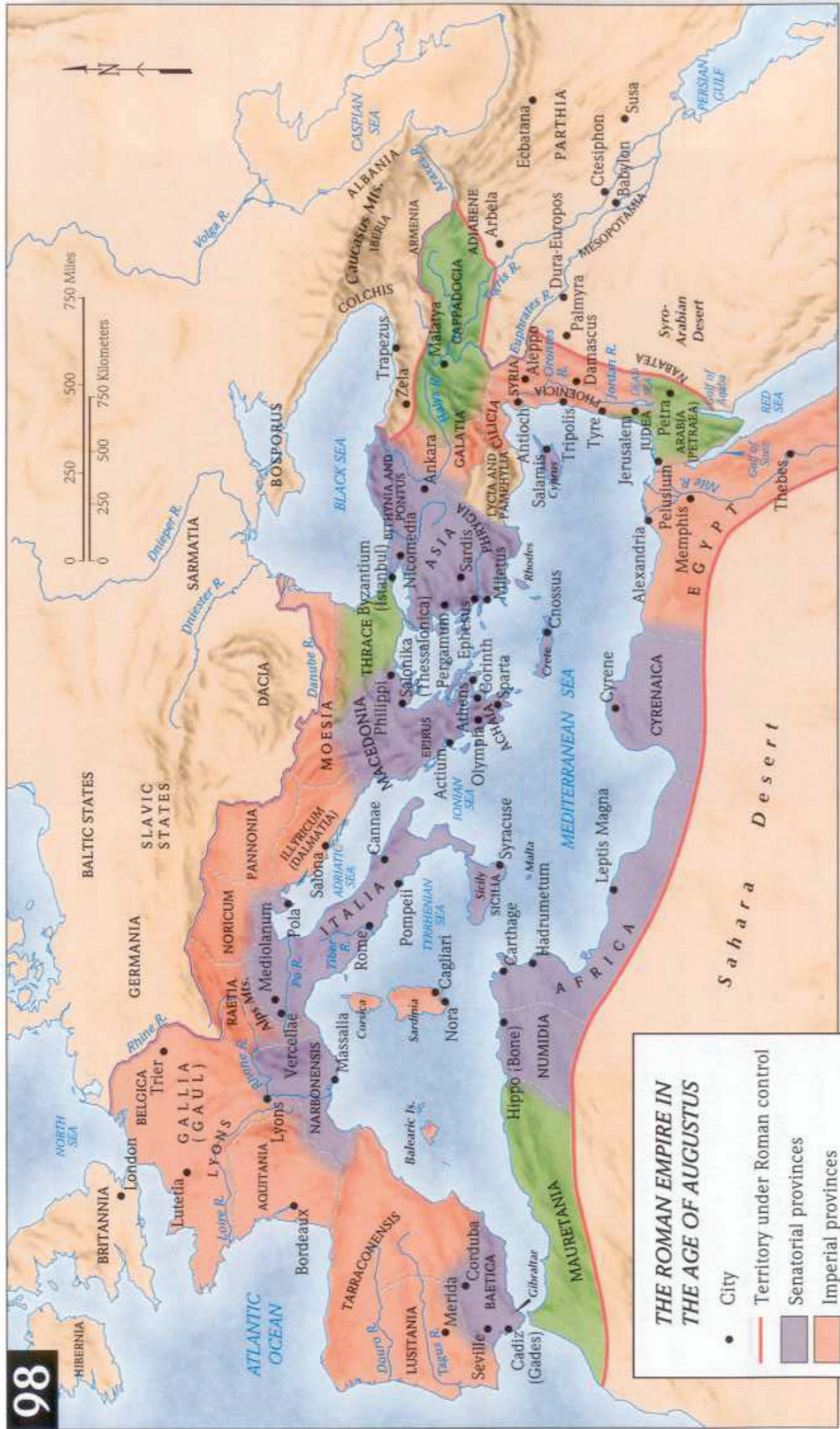
ROMAN EXPANSION IN THE THIRD AND SECOND CENTURIES B.C.

- Conquered between 200–148 B.C.
- Conquered or bequeathed to Rome between 147–100 B.C.

- Territories added from 100–65 B.C.
- Areas conquered by Pompey 64–63 B.C.
