

**SUMMARY:** The collection of the saved on earth are in Christ's kingdom.

Christ's Kingdom is the collection of the saved on earth. The sins of the Jews had not been forgiven, but had been "rolled forward" until the sacrifice of Christ. After the crucifixion of Christ, forgiveness (salvation) was available on earth. Therefore, a part of the God's kingdom was on earth.

It can reasonably be concluded that the kingdom was established on or before the day of Pentecost as Col. 1:13 reflects that Christians in the first century were being transferred to the kingdom. Matthew 16:28 reflects that some people alive at that time would see Jesus coming in His kingdom, and the only known occasion for that would be at the resurrection. The new covenant would have been established at the death of Jesus. It could then be reasonably concluded that His Kingdom was established on earth between the time of the crucifixion and the day of Pentecost.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS VERSES ABOUT JESUS' KINGDOM**

1. The Son of Man will send forth His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, and those who commit lawlessness, and will cast them into the furnace of fire; in that place there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Matthew 13:41-42
2. "Truly I say to you, there are some of those who are standing here who shall not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in His kingdom." Matthew 16:28 (Jesus' kingdom had to come in the first or second century)
3. "The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed; nor will they say `Look here it is!' or `There it is!' For behold, the kingdom of God is in your midst." Luke 17:20-21
4. Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world, if My kingdom were of this world, then My servants would be fighting, that I might not be delivered up to the Jews; but as it is, My kingdom is not of this realm." John 18:36
5. Then comes the end, when He delivers up the kingdom to the God and Father, when He has abolished all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be abolished is death. I Corinthians 15:24-26
6. For He delivered us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, Colossians 1:13 (In Jesus' kingdom at that time)

7. Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe; Hebrews 12:28 (Were already receiving kingdom before A.D. 70)
8. The kingdom will not be on earth after Judgment day, as the earth will be burned up (II Peter 3:10).
9. KINGDOM OF SATAN: And if Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself; how then shall his kingdom stand? Matthew 12:26
10. KINGDOM OF HEAVEN: Likened to a man who sowed good seed, Matt. 13:24-30, 38-43; Mark 4:26-29; to a grain of mustard seed, Matt. 13:31-32; Mark 4:30-31; Luke 13:18-19; to leaven, Matthew 13:33; Luke 13:21; to a treasure, Matt. 13:44; to a pearl, Matt. 13:45; to a net, Matt. 13:47-50; to a king who called his servants to a reckoning, Matt. 18:23-35; to a householder, Matt. 20:1-16; to a king who made a marriage feast for his son, Matt. 22:2-14; Luke 14:16-24; to ten virgins, Matt. 25:1-13, to a man traveling into a far country, who called his servants and delivered to them his goods, Matt. 25:14-30; Luke 19:12-27.
