"Everything that can be invented has been invented." Charles H. Duell, U.S. Patent Office director, urging President McKinley to abolish the office (1899)

"Man won't fly for a thousand years." Wilbur Wright, to brother Orville after a disappointing flying experiment (1901)

"I cannot imagine any condition which could cause this ship to founder. I cannot conceive of any vital disaster happening to the vessel. Modern shipbuilding has gone beyond that." E.I. Smith, captain of the Titanic (1912)

"That is the biggest fool thing we have ever done. The bomb will never go off, and I speak as an expert in explosives." Admiral William Leahy to President Truman on the atomic bomb (1945)

"I think there is a world market for about five computers," Thomas J. Watson, IBM (1958)

"The war in Vietnam is going well and will succeed." Robert McNamara, U.S. Secretary of Defense (1963)
