In 2019 the President of the Church of Christ of the Latter Day Saints received a "game changing divine revelation" that church members should no longer call themselves Mormons or use the shorthand "LDS". They should now be called "members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints" or the shorter version "Latter-day Saints".
- 5. Liquor, tobacco, tea, and coffee were prohibited in 1833. A clarification was made in 2012 when Presidential Candidate Mitt Romney was seen drinking a Diet Coke, that the church has no rule against caffeine itself (Houston Chronicle Aug 25, 2019, p. F2).
