Kindness acted out would be following the "golden rule," that is to do unto others as you would have them do unto you.

Kindness represents a balance between taking care of yourself and your family and helping or serving others. Literally, if you used all your resources to help others to the detriment of yourself and your family, you would be being kind to others, but unkind to your family.

Kindness was originated by God. The ultimate act of love and kindness was shown by sending His Son, Jesus, to die on the cross at Calvary. Jesus paid for our sins. And by offering the free gift of salvation to all who would accept His gift of kindness, we have the assurance of eternal life together with Him in Heaven.

Have you ever heard the expression "Kill them with kindness?" The idea is that even though someone may not be kind to you, if you continue to be kind to them, they will eventually be touched by your kindness, see the benefit, and want to be kind like you are. This opens the door for you to share Jesus' love with them. Unless you are kind to others, you will be perceived as unkind, unforgiving, and bitter. That behavior appeals to no one; people are drawn to kindness, so you must do your best to draw others to you, so you in turn can draw them to the Savior.

Kindness is a warm and friendly disposition toward another. A kind person is polite and well mannered, respectful and considerate, pleasant and agreeable, cheerful and upbeat, caring and helpful, positive and complimentary.

Ephesians 4:32 is a verse that Christians learn early in their study of the Bible: "Be kind and

compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Kindness critical to building relationships; even toddlers playing with blocks are told to "be kind" as they are taught to share their toys. As children get older, the concept of kindness expands to include being kind even to those who are not kind to them.

The kindness shown by God was given in spite of the fact that there were people-often His own chosen people-who rejected and hated Him, long ago and still today. But He continues to show that love and kindness and that he expects from us to mimic to the world around us. It's important that, as witnesses for Him, we show kindness every day and in every way. Some may not appreciate it as much as others, but we are not to be kind because someone deserves it. We are kind to serve others, to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

Kindness is goodness in action, sweetness of disposition, gentleness in dealing with others. The word describes the ability to act for the welfare of those taxing your patience.

Kindness is doing something and not expecting anything in return. Kindness is respect and helping others without waiting for someone to help one back. We must be kind, no matter what reaction we get from the recipient of our kindness. We should live "in purity, understanding, patience and kindness; in the Holy Spirit and in sincere love; in truthful speech and in the power of God; with weapons of righteousness in the right hand and in the left".

DEEDS OF THE FLESH: TAKE CARE OF YOU AND YOUR OWN

Antonyms of kindness are cold-heartedness, hard-heartedness, inhumanity, inhumanness, mercilessness, and pitilessness-Satans tools to counter Christian kindness.

Satan would tempt you to ignore the needs of others, to take care of yourself and your family before you consider what others might need. He would reason that you can delay the consideration of others until you have adequately taken care of yourself and your own family. Unfortunately, the term "adequately" is a moving target. As the owner of a business, I learned what the salary was that would make almost anyone happy. It was 10% more than they were making.

If you gave them a 10% raise, they were really happy for a few months until their standard of living increased to the limit of the new higher pay rate. At that time another 10% raise would make them really happy again. The temptation to take care of yourself and your family until you have surplus resources to be kind to others simply does not happen for most people. The decision to live within your means so you have surplus to be kind to others gives way to Satan's temptation to live at the limit of your resources because there are many things you "deserve". Turns out there are an unlimited number of things you can feel you "deserve", so you may never get to the point of helping others.

"Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! So great is your power that your enemies cringe before you. (66:3) Your righteousness, God, reaches to the heavens, you who have done great things. Who is like you, God? (71:19) The Lord is gracious and righteous; our God is full of compassion. (116:5) As for God, his way is perfect: The Lord's word is flawless; he shields all who take refuge in him." (18:30) (47:7) And the heavens proclaim his righteousness, for he is a God of justice. (50:6)

Now, thank God for all he does for us! "Surely God is my help; the Lord is the one who sustains me. (54:4) Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge. (62:8) Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. (100:3) Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long." (25:5) Elizabeth Brown

CHURCH GROWTH SERIES: CAN A CONGREGATION GROW TODAY?

In the February 2022 Christian Chronicle a story related:

1970s & 1980s A major metropolitan Church of Christ congregation peaked at about 2,000 members.

In 1986 the major metropolitan congregation was located 3 miles south of current location. That property was purchased by local independent congregation.

In 2022 with 400-500 on their roll the major metropolitan congregation roll had 300-400 in attendance. They had a 43,000 sq. ft. bldg. constructed in 1986 on 18 acres near downtown. They considered themselves to be a very grace-oriented church. "We've gone through that shift – and feel we've gotten healthier and stronger while diminishing in numbers." They were \$1.9 million in debt.

Between 1986-2022 the local independent church grew enough that it is now purchasing

the 43,000 sq. ft. x 18 acre facility from the major metropolitan Church of Christ with enough to pay off the debt and have some surplus cash.

A major metropolitan congregation elder echoed that desire, "We're seeing it not

as a failure – there's a sense that this is a way to live into discipleship and be more effective disciples of Jesus, with resources that allow us to make a significant impact on the kingdom." (Note: the resources mentioned are cash from the sale)

Contrarian view: In an area in which the fields were white unto harvest such that between

IN THE SAME AREA AT THE SAME TIME A CHURCH OF CHRIST DECLINED FROM 2000 TO 400 WHILE AN INDEPENDENT CONGREGATION GREW FROM 400 TO 2000!

1986 and 2022 a non-denominational group grew from needing a 400 member facility to a 2000 member facility while the Church of Christ in the same area declined from a 2000 member group to being a 400 member group. The Church of Christ judged themselves to be successful.

In looking at the 100 fastest growing congrega-

89% OF THE FASTEST GROWING CONGREGATIONS ARE INDEPENDENTS!

tions in the USA, 89 were independent community congregations, 7 were Baptists, 3 were Christian, and 1 was Presbyterian. To say it another way, 89% were independent community congregations.

As independent community congregations are even more independent than Churches of Christ, real data on them is even harder to come by than on Churches of Christ. What I have seen and heard is:

- 1. They are closer to a Church of Christ than a Presbyterian church.
- They announce specific expectations of their members, see THE BIG 10 from the Church of the Rock.
- 3. They attract young people with loud instrumental music.
- 4. They tend not to be dogmatic on a lot of topics.
- They dispense with our style bureaucracy in favor of a single pastor-leader with a clear vision.

Some starter questions:

- 1. Can we have expectations of our members and clearly state them?
- 2. Can we improve the quality and attractiveness of our worship services short of instrumental music?
- 3. Can we learn something from independents churches?
- 4. Do the scriptures allow us some organizational flexibility?
- 5. Can we find scriptural alternatives to our customary organizational style which do not tend to disenfranchise our members?
- 6. Can we objectively state what we must do to actually accomplish our part of the Great Commission?

IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION #130-MONKEY FACED FLOWERS

Dracula simia, also called monkey orchid or the monkey-like Dracula, is an epiphytic orchid originally described in the genus Masdevallia, but later moved to the genus Dracula. The arrangement of column, petals and lip strongly resembles a monkey's

face. The plant blooms at any season with several flowers on the inflorescence that open successively. Flowers are fragrant with the scent of a ripe orange.

The photograph shows some of these Orchids. You can buy seeds from Amazon.com with the brand being VictoryVentor. They literally have monkey faces on them.

To put a monkey face on a flower is a definite design, and the repeatability of it is definitely proof of complex DNA programming. Can you imagine just how much intentional DNA programming it would take to make a monkey face on a flower.

No insect would come up to it and decide to pollinate it because it looks like a monkey, if anything it would scare an insect off. That is not a "survival of the fittest" characteristic. It would tend to make them extinct.

There is no survival of the fittest reason to evolve these flowers, and to produce them requires a lot of computer-like DNA. That leaves only one answer: an Intelligent Designer created them.

What reason would an Intelligent Designer have to design and program flowers like these? There is no indication that animals appreciate the beauty and uniqueness of these flowers. The only conceivable reason for this beauty is so that humans would see them and know that there is a God.

These flowers do not just suggest that there is

an Intelligent Designer, God; they scream it. Humans would have to be naïve to look at such wonders and think, "aren't we lucky these accidents happen?" They will take that naivete to judgment day and face the Designer.






