FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT - SELF CONTROL

The last fruit Paul mentions in Galatians is selfcontrol. To exhibit self-control is to have selfdiscipline, self-restraint, willpower, and levelheadedness. Self-control means you release your own ideas and feelings even when you think they are better than others. A good example of someone exercising self-control is athletes. They work hard to bring their bodies un-

der certain parameters even though it may mean, hard work, sacrifice, and hours devoted to doing what a coach tells them to. The way they do this is to keep their eyes focused on the goals they hope to achieve. As believers, our training is to "press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:14).

Unless a believer practices self-control, he or she will be seen as selfish, pushy, overassertive, and insensitive to the needs of others. Continue your training for the prize for which God has called you. Don't ignore the fruit of self-



control. Allow it to equip you to press on and say "yes" to practice the needed skills to achieve your calling. We are called to be Christlike and live as Jesus' ambassadors here on earth.

A **great facility** might attract a lot of people. However, there numerous examples of congregations with great facilities which are lukewarm or have completely died. Clearly just having a great facility is not the answer. As a practical matter most Churches of Christ are in modest facilities and simply cannot afford a great facility. Whatever facilities the congregation has, they should be all they can be.

A number of people think **instrumental music** is the answer, but there are plenty of examples where the adoption of instrumental music has been detrimental to church growth. In some cases it has been so detrimental that the congregation has completely disappeared.

Hiring more staff appeals to a lot of people, especially leaders who are frustrated by the lack of involvement of members. Staff can help in the process, but there is a much better answer than simply to hire more staff. We have data on one congregation which grew to almost 1000 members with only three people on staff, including the pulpit minister. Years later the congregation is in decline with a dozen people on staff. As a congregation grows more staff is desirable and necessary, but would at the most be a secondary factor in church growth.

The #1 factor we are talking about is available to the smallest and largest of Church of Christ congregations. It does not strain the budget, or functionally cost anything at all. Not only does it not cost anything, but it probably directly increases contributions to your congregation. It has multiple side benefits.

Just imagine that. A factor which will increase your critical prospect traffic which does not cost anything, automatically increases your contributions, and has other side benefits.

The #1 factor in the #1 factor is member involvement:

It is generally said that 80% of the work in a congregation is done by 20% of the members. Those 20% are over worked and can typically only do the basic things which have to be done to maintain a congregation. Consider the 20% to be "very active" members.

Now, presume that 40%, 50%, 60% or perhaps more of the members suddenly become just as "very active" as the present 20%. You now have a work force two or three times as large. Imagine what you can do with that resource in time and talent. "Very active" members tend to give more that relatively inactive members as they are more committed to the cause. That will take care of our increased contribution.

What is likely to happen in most congregations would be a short-term chaos followed by discouraged members going back to the same low level of activity which you presently see. Your management style most likely will not accommodate the increased activity. We have observed two 120 member congregations merging into a 240 member congregation. Two years later it was back down to a 120 member congregation. Apparently a size their management style could handle.

Not only are most congregations not prepared to handle a major increase in member involvement, they functionally discourage it by not having a management system to handle it.

A major increase in involvement in a congregation represents a step change type organizational requirement. The organizational methods and systems which worked will likely no longer be sufficient.

Literally the current involvement level is the natural result of the congregation's present management style. Members who are self-starters

have started. **Members who** respond to the present management style have responded.

If you want to reach and motivate the next level of members to engage them, your leadership style must change. To refuse to improve your management style is to commit to continuing to get the same results you have been getting. If you are declining, you are likely to continue to decline in spite of renewed efforts at doing the same thing you have already been doing. The same thing happens in business. If you want to grow a business to be a larger style, you need to increase the management capacity.


The change in management methods and style can include a number of factors such as:

- 1. Actually having a measurable Great Commission growth goal by which most program's success are measured against.
- 2. Starting new ministries which predominately support your Great Commission goal.
- 3. A commitment that the primary role of Shepherds is shepherding.
- 4. A commitment that the Shepherds are not going to Deacon type work, but rather are responsible to appoint and mentor Deacons (and others) to do tasks which support church growth. That will free up Shepherds to do shepherding.
- 5. A commitment to delegate authority to Deacons and others in clear writing which the recipients understand.
- 6. Regular monitoring and updating of the delegated authority.

7. Upgrading your computer systems to track what is happening with regular reports to leadership.

We need to make an important point here. No leadership thinks their operating practices discourage member involvement. Many members think the operating practices discourage them, but I have yet to see a leadership who did.

With the complex interrelationships between people such as leaders and followers, there is no short answer which is good for all times, all people, and all situations. How you get your members to be as active as they should be will be unique to your congregation. You can get suggestions from other congregations, but their ideas will not simply fit your congregation. They must be adapted to fit your combination of members and resources.

Leaders need to lead their congregations in ways which emphasizes member involvement in the evangelism process. The evangelism process includes numerous steps including encountering visitors, basic teachings, asking for a commitment, further teachings, involving, and maturing the new member to be an evangelist also. Leadership is involving members in each of those steps and making sure each of these steps are done and done well.

What is the best indication your leadership methods are working or are holding you back? Are you growing?

The fruit of the spirit is the character of Jesus Christ that lives in our hearts. Bearing fruit for the kingdom is as relevant today as it was when Jesus spoke about it. And even though we may not think of ourselves as fruit, we need to realize the fruit is the sweet result of our planting, the part that others will recognize.

John 15 says Jesus is the vine and we are the branches. Without staying attached to the vine, we cannot bear fruit. John 15:5 states, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." So stay attached to the vine so that you will bear much fruit thereby showing others our love for God.

Self-control is self-mastery regardless of the circumstances, to be in control of one's self rather than to be controlled by temptations, events or other people, especially when under pressure or in times of crisis. It is to remain calm, cool and collected, reasonable and eventempered; to be alert and conscious, to proceed with caution and prudence, and to avoid an impulse or kneejerk response; to be a moderating influence; and to have the strength and courage to reject evil and choose good.

DEEDS OF THE FLESH: EXCITEMENT

Whereas self-control is self-discipline, selfrestraint, willpower, levelheadedness, Satan would not temp you to not have self-control by offering being undisciplined, unrestrained, indecisive or irrational. Satan would offer that giving up on your boring self-control would make your life more exciting. Don't be a fuddy-duddy, live a little. Do not take a long-term view of what happiness is, live for the moment.

"Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus." (I Thess. 5:18 NLT)

In Paul's concluding remarks to the Thessalonian Christians, he left a serious TO-DO list. We can benefit from taking them to heart. It all begins with gratitude.

HONOR YOUR LEADERS: "Dear brothers and sisters, honor those who are your leaders in the Lord's work. They work hard among you and give you spiritual guidance.¹³ Show them great respect and wholehearted love because of their work. And live peacefully with each other.

ENCOURAGE EVERYONE: ¹⁴ Brothers and sisters, we urge you to warn those who are lazy. Encourage those who are timid. Take tender care of those who are weak. Be patient with everyone.

DO GOOD: ¹⁵ See that no one pays back evil for evil, but always try to do good to each other and to all people.

PRAY WITH GRATITUDE & JOY: ¹⁶ Always be joyful. ¹⁷ Never stop praying. ¹⁸ Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.

TEST EVERYTHING: ¹⁹ Do not stifle the Holy Spirit. ²⁰ Do not scoff at prophecies, ²¹ but test everything that is said. Hold on to what is good." (I Thessalonians 5:12-21 NLT)

IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION #133 - LOBSTER PLEOPODS

Lobsters are invertebrates with a hard protective exoskeleton. Like most arthropods, lob-

sters must shed to grow, which leaves them vulnerable. During the shedding process, several species change color. Lobsters have eight walking legs; the front three pairs have claws, the first of which are larger than the others. The front pincers are also biologically consid-

ered legs, so they belong in the order Decapods ("ten-footed")

Lobsters, like snails and spiders, have blue blood due to the presence of hemocyanin, which contains copper. Lobsters live up to an estimated 45 to 50 years in the wild.


In general, lobsters are 25–50 cm (10–20 in) long, and move by slowly walking on the sea floor. However, when they flee, they swim backward quickly by curling and uncurling their abdomens. A speed of

5 m/s (11 mph) has been recorded. This is known as the caridoid escape reaction.

Lobsters are fairly clumsy movers and have difficulty in climbing, especially in crowded tanks in seafood restaurants and similar situations.

The attached pictures are of such a Lobster in a restaurant tank in Houston where the Lobster was trying to crawl onto the top of other Lobsters in a corner.


The claws aren't much good for climbing, but they do have some small legs which help. However when climbing up a pile, the walking legs may not touch the ground at all. The tail can make a big movement, but tends to move the Lobster backwards rather than up the pile



of other Lobsters.

The Lobsters feature the design and implementation of several pleopods (also known as swimmerets) along its abdomen to help. As is especially seen in the lower photograph, the pleopods push backwards like your hand does in swimming to move the Lobster forward and upwards.

All the Pleopods required was the recognition of the need, the invention of a solution, the



DNA programming to make it happen. Accidental evolution can do none of these. This is one more sign that an Intelligent Designer is at work. That designer is Jehovah.





This means that if you come to a clarity about a truth impacting your salvation in Heaven with Jesus, I would hope you to tell me about it.


I have come to such a clarity about our salvation in Heaven with Jesus, and I understand I should tell you about it.


