I did not have a good answer in 1972. My faith was not shaken, but I did not have a good response.

In the past 51 years I have seen and learned a great deal; I would love to have that conversation with Bobby again.

During the **Middle Ages** religious authorities overstated the case for God. Established religion and science were effectively combined, with the church deciding what was scientific truth. That the Earth was the center of the Universe (geocentric) was official church doctrine. Galileo was imprisoned for life for saying that the Sun was the center of our solar system (heliocentric).

Scientists rebelled against the church as the scientific authority, with Darwin's 1859 On the Origin of the Species being a high point in the rebellion. Armed with Darwin's book and other similar books, the case against God (substituting atheistic evolution as the "creation story") is now highly overstated. The "pendulum" has swung to the other side.

Bobby Nelson was fully armed in his atheistic point of view, and I was ill equipped to respond. Atheists picked off religious overstatements one by one, and functionally put religion into a retreat of sorts.


With the limited scientific knowledge 1859, Darwin could believe that cells were simply blobs of protoplasm which could easily evolve into different things. His teachings led to a number of overstatements of that position. Some of these are discussed in "EVOLUTIONARY FRAUDS AND ERRORS", our lesson 3.10 at www.occg.institute/topical lessons

Especially since the 3-dimensional double helix structure of DNA was described by James Watson and Francis Crick in the 1950s, things began to change. Cells are clearly not blobs. Everything we have learned about the complexity of cells teaches that they cannot be an accident of evolution. They show extreme Intelligent Design. The pendulum is starting to swing back some, but it has a long way to go.

Instead of seeing how everything could evolve, we see so clearly how impossible it would be for these complexities of creation to have accidently evolved with no design or Designer. The book which you can receive for free by subscribing or resubscribing to this newsletter shows more than 100 things which were impossible for atheistic evolution to do.

We do not need to be defensive because atheistic "scientists" regularly come up with new proofs which will soon be debunked. We need to know that God is real and created the heavens and the earth.

## WHAT IS PERSONAL EVANGELISM?

**Most** youths believe that the culture they are growing up in is the best place for them to be. Their culture is typically embraced by their authority figures (parents and teachers) and has been presented to them in positive terms. The negatives of their culture are not normally addressed, or are minimalized at the best.

If the culture being discussed involves religion and it is not Christianity, there are sadly few of these young people who could find a Bible, read it and become convicted of its truths. Christianity is likely to have been presented to them in a negative light in the world around them, and so is a suspect religion. Their starting thoughts about Christianity will not be positive.


In our churches today most youths are baptized. Their conversions are frequently some-place between belief and social acceptance, whether the youth actually believes he or she will likely remain in the church: If they are being baptized for social acceptance, they are likely to leave the church. It has been said that baptism of young members offsets the deaths of older members; while that may have been true in the past, but it does not seem adequate today. Our brotherhood is in decline in 2024, which means most of our congregations are in decline. With the after-effects of Covid, it is hard to tell how much our decline is, but we are in decline.

In the 1960s era of Jule Miller filmstrips, it was reasonable to say that we were being evangelistic as a group. We were aided by a general society support of religion. Society is very different today. Instead of supporting religion, society is generally against religion. While much of society is may be in general, "religious" today, the media is completely overtaken over by people with an anti-religious point of view. The news you (and your kids) hear characteristically has a very negative view of religion.

The point to this is that somewhere between the 1960s and now things have changed dramatically.

We have rested on our past laurels as one of the fastest growing religious groups, and hardly noticed that we stopped growing and fallen into a decline.

We stopped doing personal evangelism so long ago that we don't even know what it looks like today. Brother Washington' evangelism was a pleasant surprise.

## IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION #139: EAR DESIGN

I have had a goal for years to find out how much DNA information it takes to make an ear. Not the complex inner workings of the ear, just the visible portion on the side of your head. Your ear has a design, and the details for that design are stored someplace. If anyone knows the answer to this, I



cannot find it. Your ears are as unique as your fingerprints. It is just not as easy to make a paper copy of them.

Let's look at a little reality.

When a female human egg is fertilized by a male sperm, the combination is called a Zygote. The Zygote is a single cell and is a living human being. It contains all the information which will be used to become a full sized human being. It is about 0.12 mm (0.0047") in diameter and is one of the largest human cells. A typical sheet of Xerox paper is about 0.003" thick, so the cell is as thick as 1 ½ sheets of Xerox paper.



The Zygote will implant in the uterine wall, and will have an umbilical cord as a lifeline to the mother. The umbilical cord has no nerves

for transmission of information to the Zygote, so the Zygote has all the information that it needs to make an ear.

The zygote begins its journey down to your uterus

over the course of about one week. During this journey, the zygote divides many times, eventually creating two separate structures. One structure eventually becomes the embryo (and later, the fetus) and the other becomes the placenta.

The Zygote goes on to form as many as 400 different types of cells. The graphic to the left illustrates some of the cells which come from the Zygote. There is no information coming from

any other source; the massive amount of information needed to form all these and the other of the 400+ types of cells is within the Zygote. The embryo begins to develop, using solely the information programmed into it from the very beginnings

of the fertilized ovum


doesn't lt. stop Individual there. cell types formed into complex organs. The graphic to the right illustrates a few of these organs. Just imagine how complex a heart, lung, brain, intestine, and skeleton are. These complex designs don't appear out of thin



air. The information to make these wonderful designs were in the Zygote.

For decades, 98% of our DNA was written off as junk DNA. Scientists didn't know what it did, so it was declared to be junk.

I don't know where in the DNA the design of the ear is, but I know the design of the ear had to be in the Zygote. I am comfortable in believing that, in some part of the 98% of DNA which scientists called "junk DNA," exists is the information for the design of the ear. I don't know how much or where, but I am sure it is there. I am also comfortable in believing that the design of the 400+ cell types and the design of the rest of the body is there.



Basically, I believe there is little if any junk DNA; rather, I believe we have junk science saying that there is junk DNA.

If you know or learn how much DNA it takes to make an ear, please let me know.




