INTRODUCTION:

Mark 10:45— "...a ransom for many..."

(:) "What does the word 'ransom' mean?"

(The price paid to get something or someone back.)

- WHEN SOMEONE IS KIDNAPPED, THEIR FAMILY MUST PAY A RANSOM TO GET THEM BACK. WE WERE KIDNAPPED FROM GOD BY THE DEVIL."
- What did Jesus pay to get us back for God?

(He gave his life.)

A. The Bad News—What Sin Can Do to Us:

1. Luke 12:42-48— "...beaten with many blows..."

What can sin do to us?"

(We will be beaten.)

- 2. John 8:34— "...everyone who sins is a slave to sin..."
 - (:) "What can sin do to us?"

(We become slaves to sin.)

- 3. Acts 17:30-31— "...He commands all people everywhere to repent..."
 - (What can sin do to us?"

(We will be judged by God.)

- 4. Romans— "...wages of sin is death..."
 - What can sin do to us?

(We deserve death.)

5. OPTIONAL

- 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 "...not inherit the kingdom of God..."
- (:) "What can sin do to us?"

(We will not go to heaven.)

2 Corinthians 11:13 "...deceived by the serpent's cunning..."

"What can sin do to us?"

(We will be separated from God like Adam and Eve.)

Galatians 5:19-21 "...will not inherit the kingdom of God..."

(What can sin do to us?"

(We will not go to heaven.)

Ephesians 2:1-3, 12 "...without hope and without God..."

(What can sin do to us?"

(We have no Christ, no hope, no God.)

"What can we do to get back to God?"

[You can illustrate this by placing your pen on the table. Then say to your friend, "God tells me not to pick up this pen. If I pick it up, what have I done? What happens to me?" Now pick up the pen. "What just happened?" Review with your friend the 'Bad News.' "If I want to get back to God, what can I do?" Put your wedding ring on the table. "What if I am a good husband? Will that get me back to God?" (No!) Put your wallet on the table. "What if I give money to charity? Will that pay for my sins?" (No!) Put your hand on top of all of these items. "What if I live a good life and help many people? Will that save me?" (No!)]

(He became sin so we could become righteous.)

1 Corinthians 15:56-57 "...victory through our Lord..."

(What can Jesus do for us?"

(He gives us victory over sin and death.)

2. Romans 6:23 "...the gift of God is eternal life..."

(What can Jesus do for us?"

(He gives us the free gift of life.)

- 3. Acts 4:12 "...salvation is found in no one else..."
 - (:) "What can Jesus do for us?"

(He is the only one who can save us.)

- 4. John 8:36 "...you will be free indeed..."
 - (:) "What can Jesus do for us?"

(Jesus can set us free from sin and the bondage of sin.)

- 5. Luke 23:34 "...Father forgive them..."
 - (What can Jesus do for us?"

(Jesus can ask God to forgive us.)

6. Mark 10:45 "...a ransom for many..."

(:) "What can Jesus do for us?"

(Jesus can pay the price for us to get back home to God.)

(Who can save us?"

(Jesus and only Jesus.)

(What did He do to save us?"

(He died to save us.)

(:) "Why did He save us?"


(Because He loves us.)
