Separation of Church and State is not in this nation's founding documents. The first amendment was set up to limit government interference in churches and not church participation in government.

The 1954 Johnson Amendment is a provision in the U.S. tax code that prohibits all 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations from endorsing or opposing political candidates. It is presently under court

challenge for limiting free speech. It does not say you cannot discuss policies in churches.

Gary Hamrick does not endorse or oppose either of the presidential candidates, but rather speaks more to the policies which are being presented.

Friendship evangelism is a method of sharing the gospel by building friendships with people and eventually sharing the good news with them. It can be an effective way to reach people who might not accept a tract or be offended by a direct approach. It is the least stressful way to share the Gospel and reflects a lifestyle rather than a specific act. It is probably reasonable to say that most of the other styles begin with friendship evangelism, at least to some extent. Other methods of evangelism do not work unless you have a friendly relationship with the prospect. There is no such thing as antagonism evangelism.

That being said, if you are able to convert a prospect simply because you are friendly with them, you have dunked a friend. You likely have an uncommitted Christian. Someone who has been initiated by baptism into your social club.

If you have not had discussions about actually following the scriptures, we will likely lose them to the next friendlier group which comes along. Other groups tend to be "friendlier" as they have fewer rules to follow. The challenge is to change not only "name," i.e. to Christian, but to change behavior in accordance with Jesus' teachings.

Abortion, instrumental music, divorce, homosexual conduct, women being more active in worship, scriptural church organization and attendance expectations are just a few of the topics which add a negativity to Churches of Christ when they follow the scriptures.

When you do not follow up a baptism with a determination to teach the new convert what the Bible teaches on subjects such as these and ground them, you can expect a high percentage of them to leave before long.

If a person does not realize that the New Testament gives some rules for us to follow and that the Churches of Christ are unique among named groups in following these teachings, they have no reason to not move on to a friendlier church, one closer to home, one with a better building, or one with a better kids' program.

While we are teaching new converts, we need to make sure we are teaching our kids also. We have had a generation of many of our youth ministers focusing on relationships rather than doctrines, and the church will pay the price for that.

I knew one brother who seemed to baptize someone every other week. The odd thing was that after being baptized, you characteristically never saw them again. I visited another congregation of about 400 members which baptized about 400 people a year for several years, and still had 400 members. These are real things that are happening today; you don't have to make this up for effect.

We must focus on maturing young Christians so that "As a result, we are no longer [to be] children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming; (Ephesians 4:14) Those words are directly from the New Testament.

In summary, if you are trying to grow your Church of Christ congregation with friendship evangelism only, it is likely a short-term benefit, and deadly in the long term. When your members choose to move to a denomination or to skip church all together, it likely indicates a failure in grounding them.

Possibly a worst case is after a time when you end up with a majority of untaught members in your congregation, and you can become outvoted by them. Literally outvoted.

We must win because we are standing for the truth, and we must always stand for the truth.

"Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful." (Col. 5:15 NIV)


Every soul must have freedom, be strong and courageous and willing to change when he/she

IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION #148: FOAL SLIPPERS

Foals are typically born in the anterior or cranial presentation. This means they are born head and front feet first. This means that the hoofs would tend to lacerate the birth canal walls during delivery. Humans are born headfirst 97% of the time, but do not have sharp hooves to complicate the delivery.

When the foal is born, the DNA of the mother and the foal are already determined, so evolution as a solution to this problem is not possible simply based on timing. At birth, a filly already possesses (within the ovarian cortex) all the egg cells that she will

have in her lifetime. She cannot pass on DNA from something she has learned to her children as the DNA she will pass on is already set at birth.

It would take a third-party designer, an Intelligent Designer) to solve this problem.

The solution is foal slippers, also called golden slippers, fairy fingers, and horse feathers. They are shown in the upper picture. The foal slippers are a soft keratin hoof covering which protects the birth canal from the sharp hooves, and protects the womb during pregnancy.

Keratin is the key structural material making up scales, hair, nails, feathers, horns, claws, hooves, and the outer layer of skin among vertebrates (animals without spines).

The foal slippers are a soft rubbery form of keratin which start to dry out moments after birth.

Another thing an Intelligent Designer would do would be to reuse this module of programming information on other animals. It is in fact reused on donkeys, zebras, cows, deer, and rhinos. In equines, they are shed soon after a foal begins to stand. The shedding process can vary from dropping-off whole to the gradual wearing down.

Of the seven characteristics identified as impossible on page 8 of the IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION book*:

1 something from nothing, 2 lasts forever, 3 blind complexation, 4 irreducible complexity, 5 compromising evolution, 6 new DNA programming, and 7 non-physical developments, foal slippers would be identified as impossible only because they require new DNA

programming. However, one impossible makes it impossible.

This is one more spectacular proof that our Intelligent Designer, God, is taking care of us.





WINGS OF EAGLES VIDEO PERSONAL EVANGELISM STYLES



SUMMARY: There are several basic styles of personal evangelism which describe how most of us operate. They are Friendship, Direct, Intellectual, Testimonial, Relational, Invitational, Service, and Closing. Most of our activities will have a predominant style supported by other styles.

Styles of evangelism are: Direct, Intellectual, Testimonial, Relational, Invitational, Service, and Closing. Every single person has God-given gifts and abilities that fall predominantly into one of these approaches. Usually, individuals will also have secondary characteristics rather than being all of one type. The style you use in a personal evangelism encounter will frequently be determined by the situation you are in and with whom you are talking.

Friendship evangelism

One method is sharing the gospel by building friendships with people and eventually sharing the good news with them. It can be an effective way to reach people who might not accept a tract or be offended by a direct approach. It is the least stressful way to share the Gospel and reflects a lifestyle rather than a specific act. It is probably reasonable to say that most of the other styles include friendship evangelism.

The Direct Approach: Peter in Acts 2

Peter addresses the crowd on Pentecost and boldly proclaimed the Gospel to those who are present. It is very direct. Those who have this gift get straight to the point. They preach Christ and they seek a response. The issue isn't forced but the person using this approach directs the conversation to a discussion on faith.

The Intellectual Approach: Paul in Acts 17

Paul reasoned with philosophers and deep thinkers in Athens. Today this is practiced by apologists and other logical thinkers. The intellectual evangelist is challenged to have an excellent knowledge and understanding of the Gospel. This approach is becoming more important in today's world.

The Testimonial Approach: John 9

Storytelling. Storytelling has been an effective method of teaching since the beginning of humanity. This approach uses a very natural, conversational way to evangelize; it is basically sharing our story. Sharing personal stories of one's own walk with Christ often carries unique weight, telling of experiences that facts alone cannot provide. One of the best Biblical examples is the story of the blind man in John 9 healed by Jesus. When he was asked who healed him, he replied, "Whether he is a sinner or not I do not know. One thing I do know is that I was blind, but now I see."

The Relational Approach: Luke 5:27-29

Building a relationship before you become evangelistic can be a critical force in reaching others. Some people's evangelistic abilities come from the natural ability to relate to people. The story of the calling of Matthew in Luke 5:27-29 is a great biblical example of this approach. Jesus sees Levi in his tax collecting booth and calls him saying, "Follow me." Levi (Matthew) follows him and invites several guests to his house for dinner that night with Jesus. This approach places a high value on building relationships. This requires, it must be noted, a commitment of time, because relationships take time and energy to build trust.

The Invitational Approach: The Disciple Andrew in the Gospels) Woman at the Well in John 4.

This approach is similar to the Relational approach. However, it is characterized predominantly by inviting people to church events such as services, retreats, Bible studies, and other faith-based activities. It is definitely one of the most natural and easiest ways new believers can reach out to others. It is particularly helpful to those who feel they don't have the right words. These evangelsts are assisted when the congregation has special events to invite visitors to attend. Those hosting and participating in the events are doing personal evangelism also if someone is taking advantage of the event to invite someone to come.

The Service Approach: Tabitha (Dorcas) in Acts 9.

A person who prefers this approach enjoys sharing the love of Christ through deed over word. They find this approach to be easy because it is the way God made them. Service evangelism is at the heart of the Christian faith. It provides opportunities to begin discussions and gives others a reason to accept that you are sincere. Individuals hosting, helping with, and participating in service projects are doing personal evangelism, if someone else is using the project to do personal evangelism.

Closers: Peter in Acts 2

Some members have a lot of talent at starting the evangelism process but can never quite close the commitment. Some people are good closers. This is a special talent and should be utilized.

Team Effort

A personal evangelism program at a congregation will likely have members fitting into all these categories. Some individuals may do well in one of the categories such as the service approach. When they engage someone with a greater interest than they can satisfy, the evangelism process can hand the prospects off to another member with a different skill set. It can be team cooperation to bring someone to Christ, and a team effort to mature that person after baptism.
