"Love does not delight in evil but rejoices in truth."


"It always protects, always trusts, always hopes [for repentance, reconciliation, forgiveness], always perseveres".

Love seems to be both an intuitively spirit characteristic / manifestation (as an infant loves), and a product of spiritual maturity through increasing knowledge and collaboration with the Holy Spirit when one chooses to follow Jesus.

Paul describes the personal nature of comprehending love: "When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put childish ways behind me. Now we see but a poor reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. And now these three remain: faith hope and love. But the greatest of these is love."

The commentary of the Life Application Study Bible explains "in morally corrupt Corinth, love had become a mixed-up term with little meaning. Today people are still confused about love. Love is the greatest of all human qualities, and it is an attribute of God himself. (1John 4:8) Loves involves unselfish service to others; to show it gives evidence that you care. When faith and hope are in line, you are free to love completely because you understand how God loves."

IMPOSSIBLE FOR EVOLUTION #150: DARWIN'S BARK SPIDER

As a mechanical design engineer, I have used many grades of steel and other non-steel metals. The most common is mild steel in the grade A-36 which has a yield strength of 36,000 p.s.i. (pounds per square

inch). This means that if you take a bar 1.128" in dia. (will have a 1.000 sq. in. area) and pull it with a force of 36,000 lbs., it will begin to yield.

Some of the other materials I have frequently worked with are 4130 28-36 Roc "C" hardness (95-161,000 yield), Pipe API 5L – X52 MTR, 52,000 PSI min yield p.s.i, API 2H PLATES 50, 50,000


p.s.i, 17-4 Ph St. Stl. 110,000 p.s.i. min. yield, Naval Bronze 25,000 PSI Min Yield, 6AL-4V Titanium Grade 5 95,000 PSI Min Yield, and Aluminum Plate 5086 H116 28,000 PSI Min Yield. **The highest yield strength listed is 161,000 p.s.i.** There are some special (and very expensive) steels which are somewhat stronger.

The point to this is that the tensile strength of **Darwin's bark spider's web** is 230,000 p.s.i., higher than all but the most exotic of steels. This makes the silk twice as tough as any other spider silk known. Its silk is the toughest biological material ever studied.

The silk is shown in fig. 1 being a bundle of nontwisted fibers covered with 2 layers of lipid (fat). The silk bundle is 0.000,393 inches in diameter. Human hair is about 0.001 inches in diameter or about 3 times as thick as this silk. The fibers within the bundle are 0.000,005,315 inches in diameter or less than 1/300th of the size of a human hair. This is smaller than the smallest wavelength of light so you cannot even see them in a normal microscope.

With the silk bundle being 0.000,393 inches in diameter and the fibers within the bundle are 0.000,005,315 inches in diameter, it will take about 40,000 fibers to build a bundle. That means that the spider must have 40,000 individual fiber extruding nozzles plus two concentric nozzles for the layers of lipid (fat).

Darwin's bark spider is an orb-weaver spider that produces the largest known orb webs (circular web see fig. 2), ranging from 1-30 sq. ft., with bridge lines spanning up to 82 ft. (see fig. 3). The spider was dis-



covered in Madagascar in 2009.

Darwin's bark spiders release unusually large amounts of bridging silk into the air, which is then carried downwind, across the water body, establishing

> bridge lines. (see fig. 2). They then build an orb web hanging off the bridging line (see fig. 3), and use it to trap prey. The largest prey for them is dragon flies.

> Can you imagine this spider inventing this extremely strong silk which is also so light as to

float in the air across rivers? Can you imagine this spider accidentally inventing the means to have something like 40,000 extrusion nozzles? Surely this is the work of an intelligent designer – God!!!!












CONTRARIAN #1 YOU CAN RUN FASTER THAN THE SPEED OF LIGHT

The control panel on the treadmill graphic below indicates that the man is running at 10 mph, but he is not going any place.



How do you say that he is running at 10 mph, mph relative to what? In reality he is running on a moving belt, and the belt is rotating at 10 mph.

This is very important to understand. All velocities that you have are velocities relative to something. The man is shown running at 10 mph, relative to the belt on the treadmill. If he gets off the treadmill and makes the same running motions, he will be running relative to the ground.

This discusses two different reference systems, the belt of the treadmill, and the Earth.



MULTIPLE FRAMES OF REFERENCE


The second graphic is showing the two X,Y,Z reference systems for the treadmill belt and then Earth. The top of the treadmill is moving in the direction of the red arrow.

It is important to know that he is in both of these reference systems at the same time. Likewise he is in many other reference systems at the same time.


GROWTH

Imagine you are running on the Earth at the equator. The Earth is about 7926.41 miles in diameter so the equator is about 24,901 miles around. It is rotating at 1 revolution per day, which is about 24,901 miles per day. This is 24,901/24 = 1037 mph, at the surface as is shown on the figure above. This means that you are actually moving at 1047 mph.

ORBITING THE SUN

But the earth is orbiting about the Sun at 67,000 mph, so if you choose our solar system as our your reference system, you are moving at a speed of 10+1037+67,000 = 68,047 mph. Also, our solar system is moving in our galaxy at about 560,000 mph relative to the Constellation Cygnus.

Our galaxy is moving in space at about 1,230,000 mph in the direction of Galaxy Crater or Leo, giving us a combined velocity of 1,858,047 mph.



The treadmill, Earth and Sun are specific things where you can identify a central location for your reference system.

The center of our Galaxy and the center of the universe are theoretical points, and nothing may well be there, wherever it is.

This is approximately 1/4% of the speed of light, and we don't have a clue as to how fast Galaxy Crater or Leo is moving.

This means you are running:

10 mph relative to the Earth in a frame of reference which is rotating with the Earth.

1047 mph in a frame of reference on the earth which is fixed in the Sun instead of rotating with the Earth.

68,047 mph in the frame of reference of (centered on) the Sun

560,000 mph relative to the Constellation Cygnus.

1,858,047 mph in the direction of Galaxy Crater or Leo.

You are moving at all these speeds at the same time. It just depends on Y your frame of reference. A frame of reference is a massless identification of a location. Anything, no matter how big or small, can be a frame of reference.



RUN TO THE LAMP:

Now turn a lamp on, walk 20 feet away from it. Run toward the lamp as is shown in the graphic below. As you run at it notice that light shines past you.

The light shining past you is made of millions of Photons. We are only concerned with one of the Photons passing you, Photon P237.

For the purpose of this discussion, our frame of reference will be Photon P237. We shall call our frame of reference R237. A Photon is a unit of light. The point to this is that a Photon is a real thing, it is moving at the speed of light, and it can be our reference system.

A concept to make sure you understand is that compared to our new reference system R237, Photon P237 has no velocity. The reference system is locked into the center of Photon P237 and moves with Photon P237.
