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Look, Listen, Learn, Love

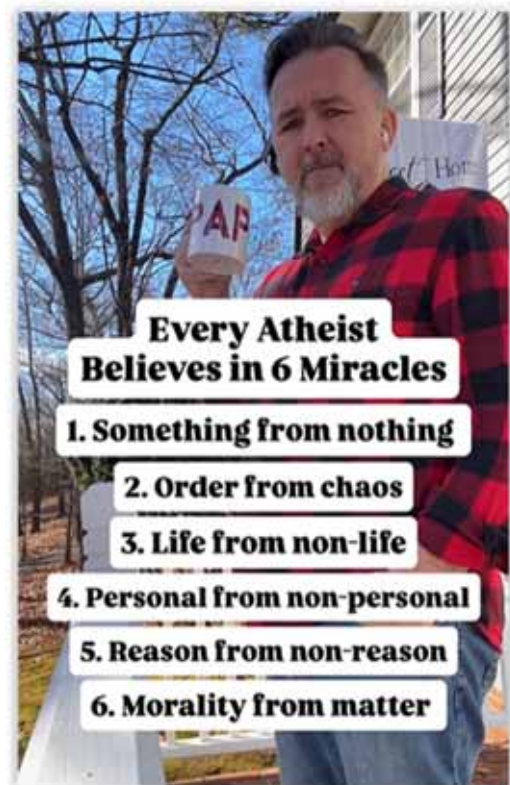
Americans staked claim to the unalienable rights to Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness.

While we have been told "Everything is permissible" – but not everything is beneficial." [1 Corinthians 10:23], the world around us offers untold forms of happiness which many people claim to "love so much that they pursue until they drop". However; we still find ourselves "Looking for Love" and "Singing the Blues". A reliable source tells us "Finally brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things." Philippians 4:8

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CHRISTIANOPHOBIC

“Christianophobic means the fear, hatred, discrimination, or prejudice directed against Christians or the Christian religion. It describes hostile acts, negative attitudes, and violence targeting Christian people, their beliefs, or their places of worship.”

“Islamophobia is the **irrational** fear, hatred, or prejudice directed against the religion of Islam or Muslims in general. It involves hostile attitudes, cultural stereotyping, and discrimination that treat Muslims as a threat, often impacting people who are visibly identifiable as Muslim or perceived to be Muslim.”

The two definitions (from Google AI) are very similar except Christianophobic includes negative attitudes, and violence targeting Christian people, their beliefs, or their places of worship while Islamophobic includes **irrational**, hostile attitudes, cultural stereotyping, and discrimination that treat Muslims as a threat, often impacting people who are visibly identifiable as Muslim or perceived to be Muslim.”

It is common today to threaten to call people “Islamophobic” and for Christians to avoid the topic. I would like to point out that the fourth word in the description above under islamophobia is “**irrational**”. If you have rational fear, would it be a different discussion?

Consider the following:

1. Iran is Islamic and has spent the last 47 years trying to build a nuclear bomb to kill us. (Is it irrational to fear them?)
2. The Quran includes 57 verses including calls to fight, including “**O Prophet, fight the unbelievers and the hypocrites, and be severe with them.**” (66 Prohibition 9) (As we nonbelievers are hypocrites to them, would it be irrational

to fear them when their “Bible” says 57 times to fight us?)

3. Global tracking organizations report that approximately **4,500 to 5,000 Christians** were killed worldwide for their faith in 2025, primarily by extremist and Islamist militant groups in sub-Saharan Africa, Nigeria, and parts of the Middle East. (Is it irrational to fear them?)

At a Glance: The 2026 World Watch List paints a grim picture for believers worldwide. Christian persecution statistics show the crisis is growing, not shrinking, and the numbers back it up. An estimated 388 million Christians now face high levels of persecution and discrimination for their faith, up 8 million from the previous year. Sub-Saharan Africa remains the deadliest region, and 15 countries now register “extreme” persecution levels.

- 4,849 Christians were killed for their faith during the 2026 reporting period
- 388 million believers face high levels of persecution globally
- 224,129 Christians were internally displaced or became refugees
- 67,843 Christians were physically or mentally abused for faith-related reasons
- 15 countries now rank at “extreme” persecution levels for Christians, up from 13

The vast majority of these persecutions and discriminations come from Muslims, in Muslim dominated countries. (Is it irrational to fear them?)

4. **Countries Where It Is Illegal to Own or Import Bibles**

In some nations, simply owning or importing a Bible is illegal, and penalties can be severe.

- **North Korea:** Possession is considered treason.
- **Saudi Arabia:** Public worship is forbidden, and importing Bibles can lead to arrest.
- **Maldives:** Importing Bibles is illegal; non-Muslim religious materials are banned.
- **Turkmenistan & Uzbekistan:**
Distribution of religious texts is heavily restricted and monitored.
- **Iran:** Distribution outside the Armenian or Assyrian communities is criminalized.

A List of Countries Where Christianity is Illegal or Suppressed

Afghanistan: leaving Islam to follow Jesus can result in severe punishments, including death, due to the country's Islamic laws. This extreme persecution comes not just from the Taliban-led central government but also from local communities and even family members.

North Korea: Being found practicing Christianity or possessing a Bible can lead to imprisonment in labor camps, families often punished as well.

Somalia: deciding to leave Islam can be lethal, often facing execution or mob violence.

Libya: Since the fall of political leader Gaddafi, Libya has lacked a stable central government, leading to a rise in Islamic extremism. Christians, particularly those from immigrant communities, face violence and abduction.

Yemen: those who leave Islam face the threat of death.

Nigeria: remains a flashpoint of Christian persecution, under Sharia law, violent clashes and extreme persecution of Christians occur frequently.

Pakistan: blasphemy laws are used to target Christians on false accusations that lead to mob violence and can result in death sentences.

Iran: leaving Islam to follow Jesus is considered apostasy and can lead to severe punishment, including death.

(With a look at the Christian persecution which happens in Muslim majority countries, is it irrational to be concerned about an expanding Muslim percentage in the USA?)

5. SHARIA LAW

Sharia law is hard to define, and apparently changes from location to location, except the following:

Hudud Crimes and Prescribed Penalties

The punishments for Hudud crimes are fixed and cannot be modified if all legal elements and evidentiary standards are satisfied. For instance:

- **Theft:** Amputation of the right hand, provided the stolen property meets the minimum value and other legal conditions.
- **Adultery:** Stoning to death for married offenders and 100 lashes for unmarried offenders.
- **Consumption of Alcohol:** Between 40 and 80 lashes, depending on judicial interpretation.
- **Highway Robbery (Hirabah):** Ranges from crucifixion to amputation or exile, depending on the nature of the crime.

6. HONOR KILLINGS

An "honor killing" is the murder of a family member—usually of a female—by relatives who believe the victim has brought shame or dishonor upon the family. Reasons include refusing arranged marriages, being in unapproved relationships, or being victims of sexual assault.

The UN Population Fund estimates that roughly 5,000 women are killed globally each year in honor-related crimes.

Note: Islamic law (Sharia) and mainstream Islamic scholars strictly forbid vigilantism and unlawful killing, categorizing honor killings as unlawful homicide in spite of its occurrence 5000 times each year.

(Is it irrational to be concerned about an expanding Muslim percentage in the USA when Honor Killings is likely a hidden agenda for some of the early arrivers?)

CONCLUSION

For anything like this within Christianity, you have to go back to the Crusades in 1095 and 1291, during the Middle Ages. Though supported by the official "church" at the time, there was certainly no support for these brutal attempts at conversion to Christianity in the Bible (they crusaders didn't even have access to Bibles), and it would be a hard case to make that these brutal conquests were religiously motivated, rather than politically.

While this would indicate that there is no rational or irrational fear of Christianity as a

violent threat, the main fear would be Christianity's proselyting the members of other religions.

At the same time, we might well have a rational concern, fear, or negative attitude about Islam.

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NARROW YOUR FOCUS: Stay in the present moment. There is

nothing here and now that is threatening. We can find peace in the present moment. It is yesterday and tomorrow that hold the power to rob us of peace. Make the present moment home base and discipline your mind to return often. Say to yourself, "Stay in the present moment."

POUR IT OUT: God is big enough to hear every bit of your anger, concern, disappointment, fear and doubt. He can handle it. He is waiting to help. Just tell him all about it. Ask God for what you need now. *"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit".* (Rom. 15:13 NIV)

WE CAN LISTEN: If you need more help, please seek out a trusted friend or counselor. Your brothers and sisters are here to help. We don't have all the answers, but we love you! *"Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful."* (Col. 5:15 NIV)

"And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Phil. 4:7 NIV)

Impossible for Evolution:

#159 LADYBUGS

Ladybugs are a widespread family of small beetles. They are oval beetles with a domed back and flat underside.

Most species are carnivorous predators, preying on insects such as aphids and scale insects. They are promiscuous breeders, reproducing in spring and summer in temperate regions and during the wet season in tropical regions. Many predatory species lay their eggs near colonies of prey, providing their larvae with a food source.

Many of them have conspicuous warning colors and patterns, such as red with black spots, that warn potential predators that they taste bad.

When a bird or some other animal tries to attack, the ladybug bleeds poisonous blood from their leg joints. The attacker tastes the bitter blood and spits the ladybug out.

Ladybug blood, called hemolymph, is poisonous to small predators like birds and lizards because it contains toxic chemicals called alkaloids. However, it is not poisonous or dangerous to humans, though touching it can cause a bad smell, minor skin stains, or mild allergic reactions in sensitive people.

Ladybugs are protected from most predators, but not from some tiny wasps called *dinocampus coccinellae*, about the size of an ice cream sprinkle. When the female wasp is ready to lay an egg, she alights near a ladybug and swiftly inserts her stinger into the underside injecting an egg into her victim along with a blend of chemicals.

When the egg hatches, the larva feeds on the fluids that fill the host's body cavity. Although the insides of the ladybug is being devoured, the outside seems unchanged. When the



larva is ready to leave its host and develop into an adult, it squirms out through a chink in the ladybug's exoskeleton.

The larvae spins a cocoon between the ladybug's legs, so the ladybug is enslaved standing over the larvae protecting it. Some ladybugs actually survive this eerie ordeal.

Some of the items of this process which are impossible:

1. A ladybug developing blood which is poisonous to others but not them.
2. A ladybug figuring how to bleed the blood out of joints when needed.
3. A wasp that knows to insert her stinger into the belly of a lady bug to insert an egg plus a blend of chemicals.
4. A larvae which comes out of the ladybug and knows to spin a cocoon between the ladybug to immobilize it for its protection.

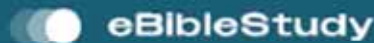
The interaction between the ladybug and tiny wasp are so complex (including DNA programming) that they could not happen by accident. They are surely the work of an intelligent designer. That intelligent designer is God.

COC WORSHIP SERVICES

I recently received a PowerPoint of a sermon lesson plan which included the following interesting statistics:

In 1937, approximately **73%** of Americans were members of a church; this remained around 70% until 2000 but has since fallen to **47%** as of 2020.

Currently, roughly **21%** of Americans report attending services every week, while **56%** say they seldom or never attend.

Nearly 1,300 Churches of Christ in the United States have closed, merged, or left the fellowship over the last decade.

Recent data indicates that since 2015, approximately nine Church of Christ congregations have closed their doors every month.

The decline has left many remaining Church of Christ congregations quite small. Approximately 54% to 55% of all Churches of Christ now average just 34 people in Sunday attendance.

In some of our studies on helping congregations grow, we had a meeting at the Harding Graduate School in Memphis. We were told that the whole basement floor was dedicated to church growth books. They apparently don't work.

Another statistic not listed above is that our congregations are graying or average members are getting older and older.

This means that our congregations have few members, older members and are in decline. Additionally, although they may want to change the situation, they do not know how to do it.

Additionally with the men available, the task of putting on services and classes is a formidable task. Frequently all their available time is consumed in these required tasks. They have little to no time for evangelism.

When they need to replace their minister, they cannot afford a dynamic younger one. They typically hire an older retired type, which matches their present audience well.

Within the OC Church Growth Institute, we have wrestled with this problem for a long time.

The assistance for smaller congregations we are providing is an online service which has the following characteristics:

Sermons by conservative world class preachers

Songs which have been used at least 20 years

No indication that these are not "your" worship services

Oklahoma Christian University has made a major investment to provide this service free to any Church of Christ congregation. The result is called COC Worship Services. They can be accessed at:

There are presently 130 AM services, 32 sermons only, 61 PM services, and 4 songs posted. The services are tailored to remove the local content from the congregation being recorded so your service will feel like yours.

WORK IN PROCESS:

We are continuing to collect worship services, songs, prayers, and communions from several conservative Churches of Christ and the OC Great Songs Chapel.

Bible classes: We are beginning to collect Bible class videos for posting. The first will be a study with Dr. Nathan Mellor of the Memorial Road congregation in Edmond, Oklahoma. This will be posted soon.

Songs: The Great Songs Chapel at OC is being recorded for use in COC Worship Services, and to be posted individually.

Children's Programs:

Mary Ellen Stolte is working on a children's curriculum for the website.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

We are dispatching interns with a TV, stand, small computer (mounted on the back), and a thumb drive holding our services and Bible classes. They would go to a small congregation to set it up and train local members to run it. After a few months our intern would go back with an updated thumb drive and switch it out. (Could be done by mail). We have an endowment for 100 of these setups to get the program started and can distribute them on the basis that the congregation agrees to use COC WORSHIP SERVICES for at least three months.

With this setup a small congregation can simply start the program with a remote control,

pause during communion, if needed, pause after the invitation song and restart for the closing song and closing prayer.

The pauses during communion are because the presenter in the video be using prepackaged communion, which is relatively fast. If your congregation is distributing trays, you will simply pause the video.

The pause after the invitation song is for you to handle your responses, make local announcements, and take up your collection.

WHAT YOU CAN DO:

Whereas the thrust of this program is to help our smaller congregations, there are things smaller and larger congregations can do to help.

HELP US IDENTIFY CONGREGATIONS One problem is that many of our congregations who might benefit from this program simply never hear of it. If you know of a congregation who could use this program, let us know.

PROVIDE RECORDED WORSHIP SERVICES: Our song services need to show the song leader and music on the screen, and our communion need to use the prepackaged cups. However, just because one portion of your service does not match our format does not mean that we cannot use other parts which do.

PROVIDE RECORDED BIBLE CLASSES: They need to be good quality lecture classes with 13 lessons.

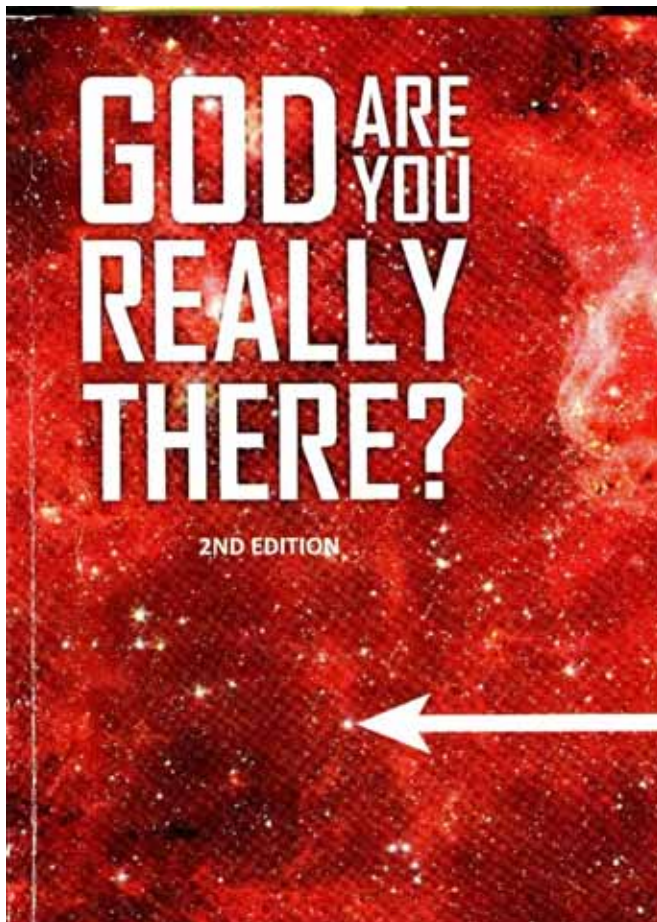
If you've ever looked at the book of Revelation and felt instantly overwhelmed, you're not alone.

This book gently walks you through the mystery, clearing up the chaos without losing the meaning. The book is available on Amazon.

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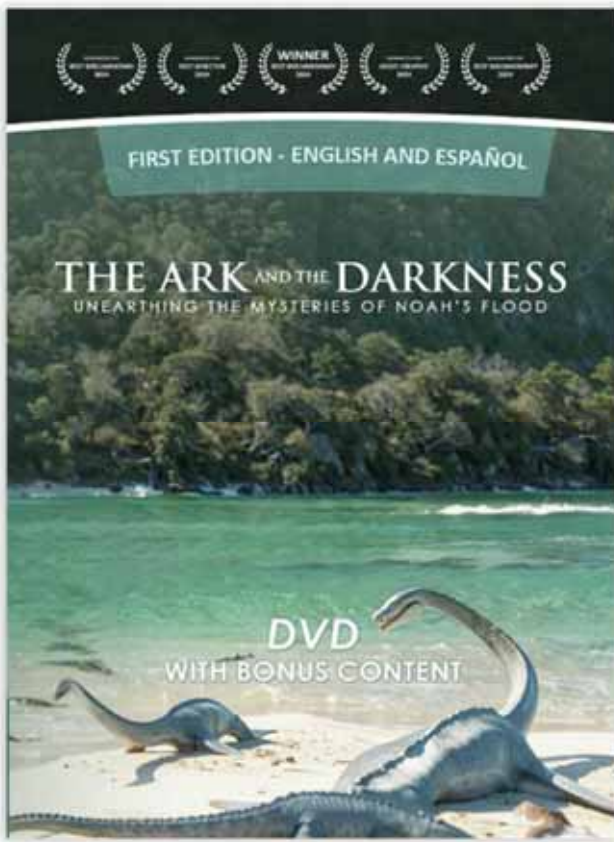


An excellent book to read by Don England. Don is an Emeritus Professor of Chemistry at Harding University where he has taught for 45 years.

My recommendation for GOD ARE YOU REALLY THERE? is that I bought a copy for



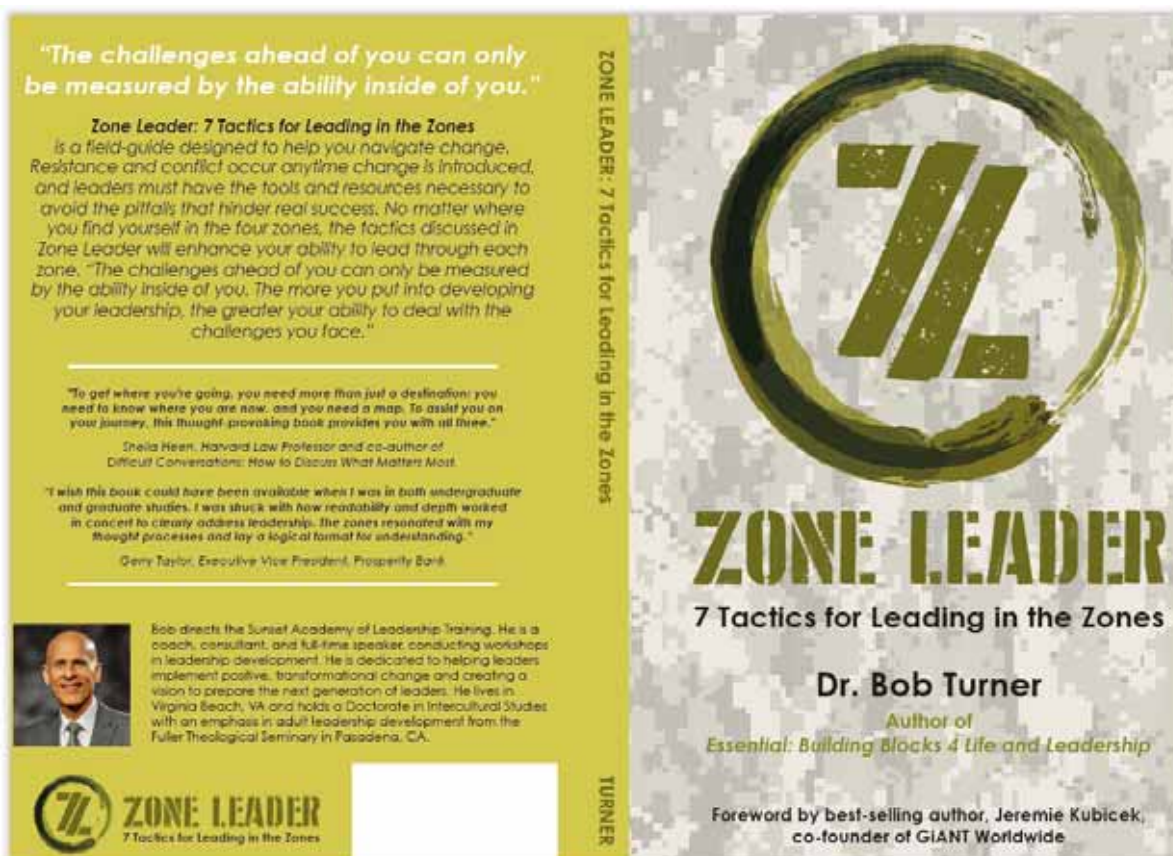
